THE POWER OF TESTIMONIES

The Bible tells us that testimonies are powerful weapons that can defeat the devil (Revelation 12:11). When you look back at the things the Lord has done, you become confident that you can overcome any obstruction that may come your way. This is why you need to keep sharing testimonies. People can doubt or debate the Bible or the existence of God, but no one can deny your personal story with God. Your testimony is one of the most effective tools in your evangelization of unbelievers. It is also an exaltation of God; a testimony can stir us to worship (Psalm 107:1-2). There is nothing like hearing a testimony when you're discouraged and even distant from God; a testimony is an encouragement for others.

Bartimaeus was a blind man who was begging by the roadside (Mark 10:46-52). He heard that Jesus was passing by and began to cry for help. How did he know that Jesus can open blind eyes? Certainly, it was because he had heard testimonies of miracles that Jesus had performed.

So, when he heard that Jesus was passing by, he knew that his miracle had come.

When David confronted Goliath, his testimonies gave him the assurance of victory (1 Samuel 17:1-51). As David said, **“The Lord who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, he will deliver me from the hand of this philistine”** (1 Samuel 17:37).

David’s testimony served as evidence that God can do it again, removing fear and doubt. Testifying solidifies our faith, reminding us of God’s intervention when we face a dangerous encounter. God kept David alive!
