



# Edward Doherty Homestead

## Location of Old Homestead Site:

North of Base Line Lane, South of Strawberry Lane, and West of Juniper Canyon Road

## Homestead Claim:

Edward Doherty acquired an 80 acre homestead claim near Juniper Canyon from the Bureau of Land Management in 1902.

Edward (Long Ed) Doherty arrived in the US in 1885. He married Anne Newman Doherty of Ballyloskey in 1895. A daughter, Catherine (Cassie), was born the next year. Edward's wife, Anne Newman Doherty, passed away two years later at the young age of 22. In 1902, Edward acquired an 80 acre homestead claim near Juniper Canyon. He married Marjery/Madge "Mary Willie" Doherty and, not long thereafter, moved his young family to New Plymouth, Idaho. The homestead at Juniper Canyon was acquired by Philip Newman Doherty, brother of Ed's first wife, Anne.

Children of Edward and Madge include: Cassie (Higgins), Charles, John Edward, Mary M., Robert P, Bernard, Agnes, Teresa, Elizabeth Florence and Lucille.

## Current Landowners:

Today, the Juniper Canyon property is owned by the Marquardt family. It is used for wheat farming. No Homestead buildings remain.

## Driving Directions:

From Lexington, take OR-207 (Lexington-Echo Hwy) north for 7.9 miles. Turn left on Barak Martin Rd. and continue for 1.2 miles. Turn left at Strawberry East Rd. and continue for 2.6 miles, crossing over Juniper Canyon Rd. and continuing onto Strawberry Lane.
