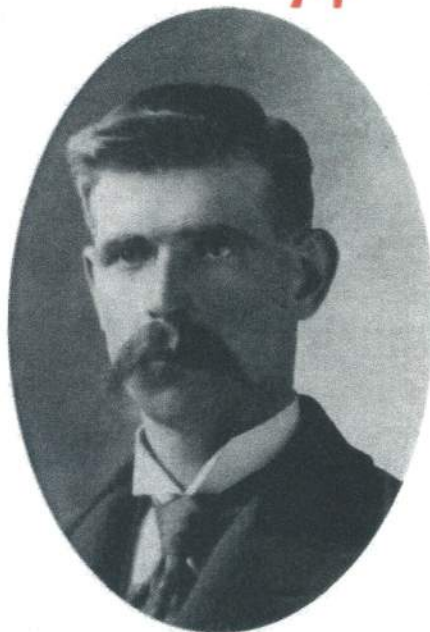

Philip Doherty Homestead

Location of Old Homestead Sites:

The Well Spring homestead is a few miles southwest of the intersection of Immigrant Lane and the lone-Boardman Road. The Juniper Canyon homesite is northwest of the intersection of Base Line Lane and Juniper Canyon Road, south of Strawberry Lane.

Philip Newman Doherty was born in Ballyloskey, Co. Donegal in 1872. He arrived in America around 1892. Philip followed his sister, Kate, to Oregon. In 1900, Phillip married Margaret (Maggie) McDaid of Glenkeen, Co. Donegal and they settled in the Well Spring area of the Sands country. Philip acquired property near Juniper Canyon from his brother-in-law, Long Ed Doherty, following the death of Long Ed's wife, Anne, (Philip's younger sister). Later, Philip acquired the Well Spring homestead claim just south of the intersection of Immigrant Lane and the lone-Boardman Road from the Bureau of Land Management.

Philip's wife, Maggie, passed away in 1913. The 1920 Census shows Philip, four sons and a daughter, living in the Well Spring area, along with Philip's younger siblings, Rose and Eugene, and his niece, Cassie. Children born to Philip and Maggie include Patrick Joseph, Edward A., Philip K., William B., and Mary Ann (Mae) Doherty Farance.

Current Landowners:

Today, the Juniper Canyon homestead is owned by the Marquardt family and is used for wheat farming.

Driving Directions:

From lone: Head north on Ella Road about 4 miles until a Y shaped intersection is reached. Bear right at the intersection onto lone-Boardman Rd. Proceed about 4.5 miles. The Well Spring homestead claim is on the right, approximately 1/2 mile south of the intersection of Immigrant Lane.
