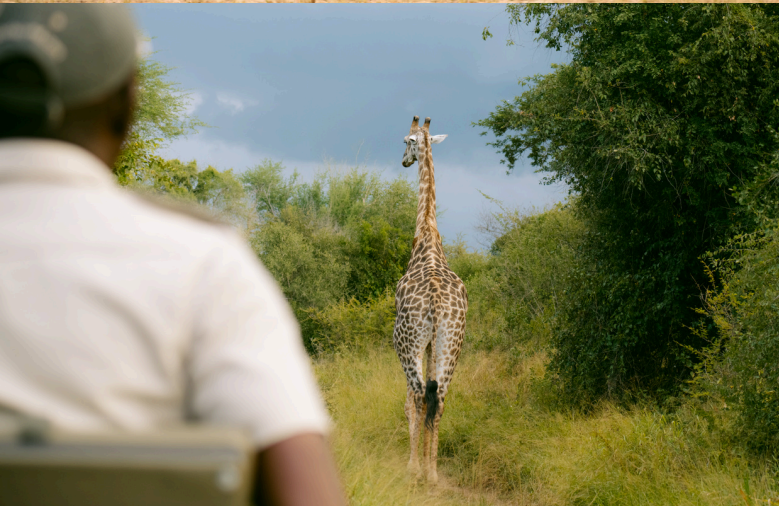

# SAFARI FACT OF THE MONTH

Our next safari adventure wraps up at one of Africa's most iconic landmarks, Victoria Falls. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this natural wonder is known locally as Mosi-oa-Tunya, or "The Smoke That Thunders."



It's one of the largest waterfalls in the world, stretching over 1.7 kilometers wide and plunging more than 100 meters into the Zambezi Gorge. At peak flow, over 500 million liters of water crash down every minute, creating a mist that can be seen from miles away. It's the perfect finale to a journey filled with wildlife, culture, and purpose.
