Dear Neighbors,

Happy belated New Year! I hope you had a great 2024 and that this year will be even better.

In 2024, HHVCA continued to focus on keeping our neighborhood a great place to live. We worked with State and County officials to improve safety on our streets. We continued to engage with County officials to minimize construction disruption and include park-like features in the planned Paul Spring Stream Restoration Project. We increased participation in our Tree Savers meet-ups. We invited neighbors to enjoy an Ice Cream Social in May, a National Night Out celebration in August, and our first Fall Fest in November. This year, we will continue these efforts and take on new challenges. We are working to expand our social media presence, and recently added a Facebook page and an Instagram account. We also want to increase the frequency of in-person meet-ups where the entire neighborhood comes together in friendship and community-building. And last, but not least, we'll continue working to protect HHV's interests.

Key to success of our activities are neighbors who plan and organize events or take on neighborhood issues. Quite frankly, we do not have enough volunteers to pursue all the areas important to our neighborhood. Some HHVCA Board/Committee positions remain unfilled. Without your participation, issues that affect our lives every day - such as education, public safety, local government budgets, zoning, transportation, and the environment - remain unaddressed. One very important issue is the County's efforts to realign school boundaries. Without your involvement, we face possible inaction on one or more of these areas and a lack of standing with elected and government officials. So please consider filling one of these open positions to help ensure our voices are heard.

I also want to encourage you to join HHVCA. Last year, less than one-third of the HHV households continued or became new members. Our dues remain \$10 a year per household. Your contribution allows us to publish the newsletter; maintain our website; maintain common areas; participate in Mount Vernon and Fairfax County-level forums; and sponsor community-wide events. The more members we have, the more we can do for the community, so please join us.
