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DANCER/PARENT INFORMATION PACKET

Included are Membership Requirements, Dance Team Responsibilities, Finances, Application Requirements, Audition Format, Audition Timeline, Schedules, Audition Results Agreement, Teacher Evaluation Forms, Health Insurance, Liability Forms, and Candidate Questionnaire. A parent or guardian signature is required on designated forms and they are to be turned in at designated times as stated in this packet.

I. MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Your dancer has decided to audition for the 2025-2026 Foothill High School Dance Team. In order to be considered, she/he must be currently approved to attend Foothill High School for the 2025-2026 year. If selected for the FHS dance team, below are the requirements and expectations to participate. The FHS Dance Team is an extremely competitive team much like any competitive dance studio that puts in long hard hours to be able to compete at an advanced and national level. Expectations are that each member treats this team as their number one priority above all other social and extracurricular activities. This may require a student to make changes to study habits, social obligations and work schedules. If you or your dancer is unable to make this commitment, this team may not be right for you.

- A. As a member of the Dance Team, a student is required to attend MANY activities in the afternoon, evenings, and weekends. It is estimated that our JV Team will spend approximately 12-15 hours a week and our Varsity Team will spend 15-20 hours a week at these functions. Each dancer will be required to attend at least three to five rehearsals per week and numerous athletic events and dance team competitions outside of required rehearsals.
- B. There are two teams: Varsity and JV Dance. The Varsity Dance Team is composed of students grades 9-12. The JV team is composed of students grades 9-11 only. Incoming freshmen may be considered for the varsity team, but the student must demonstrate *exceptional talent and maturity*. All returning Dance Team members are required to re-audition each year and previous membership **does not** guarantee that student a position on the 2025-2026 team. Placement on teams is based on the sole discretion of the judging panel.
- C. Every Dance Team member **MUST** be able to attend all new team practices beginning in May, all summer practices, summer camp and fundraising activities. Vacations should be scheduled during the approved 3-week break. No excuses will be accepted for missed dance team activities. Please see the summer schedule.
- D. The commitments of the FHS Dance Team are as much as any athletic team on campus and students receive PE/Elective credit during 6th period for their participation. That being said, students will not be able to dual enroll in both athletics and dance. Dancers are encouraged, however, to participate in other extra-curricular activities including ASB, Choir and Drama as long as it does not conflict with practices or performances.
- E. A Dance Team member may hold a job, but it cannot conflict/interfere with Dance Team Activities.
- F. Dance Team Members must enroll in 6th period Pep/Leadership or PE/Pep class for the entire 2025-2026 school year. This class can be used as Elective or PE credits.
- G. Dance Team members must maintain a 2.0 GPA. If a member is unable to reach a 2.0 GPA, that member will be placed on academic probation for the succeeding grading period and must maintain satisfactory attendance (3 hours a week) in a designated tutorial class to remain eligible. If this does not happen the student will be declared ineligible. If, at the end of the probationary grading period the student has not achieved a 2.0 GPA, they shall be ineligible for the following grading period.
- H. Dance Team members must not receive one or more unsatisfactory (U) marks in citizenship in a grading period. If a student receives one or more "U" marks, that member will be declared immediately ineligible for extracurricular activities until the next grading period.
- I. Members of the Dance Team are expected to be model students, academically and socially. They are governed by a set of guidelines in the Dance Team Code. Violations of these guidelines in terms of conduct and/or poor academic standings can lead to their expulsion from the Dance Team.

II. DANCE TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ Will attend all scheduled practices, which may include weekends
- ❖ Will attend all sports events and all competitions as scheduled
- ❖ Will attend at least one technique class outside of regularly schedule practices
- ❖ Will attend all fundraising activities of the Dance Team and Booster Club
- ❖ Will attend Summer Camp and Summer Practices
- ❖ Will be in proper uniform at all athletic and Dance Team functions where a uniform is mandated
- ❖ Will maintain a 2.0 GPA with no U marks
- ❖ Will be enrolled in 6th period Dance for the 2025-2026 school year
- ❖ Will not be involved in any school activities that will interfere with Dance

III. FINANCES

- a. The FHS Dance Team is very expensive to maintain. It is a competitive program and all costs for competitions will be outlined in a cost per person. Last year's budget was around \$50,000. Throughout the year the booster club actively holds many fundraisers to help offset costs as well as pursue corporate sponsorships and donations. The booster club depends on the participation of all members to keep this club a success. All dancers are required to attend all fundraisers and lack of full participation will impact their grade. If the team does not meet fundraising goals, the team may have to do without previously planned activities/items. A list of fundraising goals will be presented at the new dancer meeting.

IV. AUDITION FORMAT

- a. Dancers will attend 2 days of intensives and 1 final audition day. Intensives will take place April 14th from 4:00pm-7:30pm and April 15th from 4:00pm-7:30pm. Auditions will take place April 16th by appointment beginning Wednesday afternoon in the FHS Dance Room. Callbacks will be conducted by appointment on April 17th.
- b. Dancers' performance throughout this 3-day period will determine your selection for the FHS Dance Team as well as placement within each team. A portion of your audition will be based on your grades, teacher evaluations, past performance, attendance, attitude, working relationship, dependability, following directions, attentiveness, timeliness, learning skills and overall work habits. The largest portion of the audition will be based on the evaluation of physical aspects to include dance technique, dance style, advanced tricks, pom technique, strength, coordination, flexibility, sharpness, placement, knowledge of the routine, jumps, ability to learn quickly, teaching ability, and showmanship. Evaluations of dancers will begin from the first day we meet to the last day of auditions.
- c. The judging panel including Coach Marrison will select placement for all teams. The Junior Varsity team competes in two styles: Pom & Jazz. The Varsity team competes in three styles: Pom, Jazz & Team Performance. Squad size and composition will be determined by the natural break in ability. Alternate positions may be given but are not guaranteed.
- d. An applicant's eligibility to participate in competition will be continually evaluated based on the individual's dance, jump, flexibility and advanced trick technique. Being a part of the Dance Team is a privilege, not a right, and a member's participation in performances may be revoked at any time if the member fails to comply with all Dance Team rules and responsibilities. If a dancer is unable to dance during multiple practices because of an injury or illness she/he may be moved to an alternate.
- e. You must wear appropriate practice clothes (ex. Fitted shorts, a fitted top, a sports bra and jazz shoes). Please wear black, gold, white or all three colors on the day of final audition. Absolutely NO

JEWELRY OR PIERCINGS OF ANY KIND. All of your hair must be up and in a tight ponytail with a hair tie (NO scrunchies or clamps). No gum is allowed. Please bring water.

- f. Throughout the audition process dancers will learn and be evaluated on the following material:
- Strength and stretch combo
 - Across the floor and center floor technique
 - Three (3) dance combos that includes advanced tricks, hip hop, jazz and pom technique
 - Ability to learn choreography quickly and take correction
 - Advanced Tricks: Leaps in second, Toe Touches, Switch Leaps, Leg Hold Turns, Turns in Second, Triple or More Pirouettes, etc.
- *All skills will be taught and demonstrated prior to evaluation as well as a detailed description of competitive dance team minimum requirements is attached below.
- g. Please be early and begin warming up as soon as you get there. **DO NOT BE LATE!**

FAILURE TO FOLLOW ANY OF THE ABOVE DIRECTIONS WILL AFFECT YOUR OVERALL STANDING.

- h. Notification of new squads will be emailed to both the dancer and the parent Friday afternoon and will be posted on the Foothill Dance social media platforms and website. Competition teams will be posted in the FHS Dance Room window. *If you are unable to fill the position you have been offered, please email Marrissa Maizland at Coachmarrissa@gmail.com no later than Monday, April 21st by 12:30pm.*
- i. All decisions of placement and acceptance on the FHS Dance Team are FINAL. The FHS School Administration supports this. With so many talented dancers each year, it is an extremely difficult job for the judging panel to make these selections. It is done with much thought, expertise and professionalism. Each candidate will be diligently and carefully evaluated to make the best decision for the FHS competitive dance team. We understand that this audition process is difficult, time consuming and stressful. If you do not make the team, please feel free to reach out to Coach Marrissa if your dancer would like feedback once tryouts have been completed.

V. AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

- Dancer and a Parent/Guardian must attend the information meeting on **Wednesday, March 5th** from 7:00-8:30 pm.
- Dancer and a Parent/Guardian must fill out and sign the Grading Policy, Competitive Dance Team Minimum Requirements & Audition Application & Results Agreement.
- Dancer must have at least a 2.0 GPA with no more than one U's in citizenship on your Fall Semester Report Card or 3rd Quarter Grades to be eligible to audition. **Attach a copy of your Fall Semester Report Card or a transcript to the back of your tryout application.**
- Dancers must attach a recent headshot to your Audition Application. (Photos will NOT be returned.)
- Dancer must complete the Personal Information Card & Skills Sheet.
- Foothill Athletic Clearance Form must be completed and uploaded to athleticclearance.com by **THE FIRST DAY OF AUDITIONS.**
- The signed Audition Application & Results Agreement, Grading Policy, Competitive Dance Team Requirements, copy of Report Card, recent Photo, Personal Identification Card, Personal Skills Sheet, Attendance Printout, and Discipline Printout **must all be turned in at the Parents' meeting on Wednesday, March 5th.**

- h. Each dancer must have at least 4 recommendations submitted in an envelope. Three current school teacher evaluations and one current dance instructor. ***They must be received by Friday, April 11th by 4:00 pm, attention Dance (Mailbox in Athletics Office) or emailed to Coachmarrissa@gmail.com by the selected teacher.***
- i. All dancers must be free of any health problems which would aggravate or make her unable to participate in ALL Dance Team requirements and activities, which include: strength and stretch, jumping, turning, etc.

Grading Policy Requirements

2025-2026 FHS COMPETITIVE DANCE TEAM AUDITIONS

Your grade for this course is broken down into 4 areas. Everyone starts the course with 250 points. So the good news is everyone starts with an “A”! The bad news is you can lose points very easily. Each time you don’t comply with the requirements of one of the four areas, you lose 10pts. That means if you get five marks against you, your grade goes down to a “B”. The following are the four graded areas:

- ❖ Being On Time- Being on time to everything! Practices, buses, competitions, games and more.
- ❖ Being Properly Prepared at Practice, Games and Other Events- You must be dressed in proper dress out uniform and performance ready at all times. If you lose an article of your uniform you must purchase another. No special items added to your uniform. (No jewelry, bright nail polish, etc.)
- ❖ Having A Positive Attitude - You must have a positive attitude at all times- no rude commentators, no divas, no whiners, no grumps! Foothill Dance Team members are here for a fun and competitive experience. They uphold a high moral standard and are ambassadors on and off campus. A positive attitude includes respect towards your fellow teammates, dance team parents, admin, Foothill students, fellow competitors and your coach.
- ❖ Having Regular Attendance- All practices are MANDATORY and work schedules, doctor appointments, vacations, haircuts, homework and life in general must be planned around the dance teams schedule. Football games, basketball games and competitions are MANDATORY. If your absence is unexcused thirty points will be automatically subtracted from your grade. If you have more than three unexcused absences you may be removed from the competition teams and or benched from the games. Leaving an event unexcused will result in removal from the program.

The grading scale is as follows:

100-90% of total points=A

89-80% of total points =B

79-70% of total points=C

69-60% of total points=D
