A Note from Pastor Amanda

Dear ones, my own words tend to fail me lately, my own thoughts clouded by the multiple layers of stress heaped upon us all. I've found great comfort in words that are not my own – looking to God's Word (Jesus) and words of faith (the Bible) to see me through.

As I write, we have 13 days till the election and we are all aware that the political contention will not be ending even then. So I submit to your faithful reflection the words of James 4:1-10:

"Those conflicts and disputes among you, where do they come from? Do they not come from your cravings that are at war within you? You want something and do not have it; so you commit murder. And you covet something and cannot obtain it; so you engage in disputes and conflicts. You do not have, because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, in order to spend what you get on your pleasures. Adulterers! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. Or do you suppose that it is for nothing that the scripture says, "God yearns jealously for the spirit that he has made to dwell in us"? But he gives all the more grace; therefore it says, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble." Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Lament and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy into dejection. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you."

This is our role in the middle of the struggles around us. We are called to recognize our own motivations and "cleanse our hands" with "lament and mourning", submitting ourselves to God's way in this world that sometimes causes enemies, but not because we've fought for our own way.

And here's the clincher from verse 6, the words that meet me, and I hope meet you, just where you are in the middle of the fighting: God gives all the more grace, opposing the proud and giving grace to the humble.

May we walk humbly through disagreements and pandemic, looking for the ways God's grace meets us and keeps us going.

I'd like to thank everyone for their thoughts, prayers and cards of sympathy, comfort and peace. We were able to bring my mom home on her 101st birthday and



Master Calendar and Goal Check: Increase church visibility: completed! Engage youth and children: Nancy Uptgraft took 3rd -



Treasurer's report: Undesignated checking: \$10,490.74; Designated Checking: \$10,695.32; Debit Card checking: \$2,833.55; Savings: \$7,198.59. We are doing okay because of the CARES funding; otherwise we would be in the hole \$12,000. Tithes are increasing slightly. Bills are all paid except one payroll (3 paydays in October).

Pastor's report: Worship equipment is being fine-tuned. New equipment should be ready for Reformation Sunday. Nominating Team is actively seeking leaders. Currently doing Boundaries Training with the Synod. Finishing Philippians bible study and will do an Old Testament study next. Preparing for Confirmation classes. Broken window will be fixed mid-November.

Ongoing Business:

- Covid-19 Mitigation Plan will be revisited in November and possibly another phase added. Issue of home communion will also be revisited.
- Still waiting on instructions for how to close out the PPP loan/grant program.
- Total expended for worship streaming equipment was \$6,892.22. A new computer was needed to upgrade. All funds and equipment were donated. The switch to GCI from ACS for necessary streaming capabilities increased costs from \$126.79 monthly to approx. \$250.
- Because of Covid-19, we will not have an in-person Reformation party, but a Zoom call after church with a KAHOOT Reformation game is planned.

New Business:

- Computer and Internet Policy, Operational Ethics Policy, Cold Weather Policy all passed.
- Rees family will again donate beef to help fund our fuel bill.
- Office Manager's raise, voted for at 2019 Annual Meeting, will date from her annual review.
- Nov 8 Annual Meeting: Council members may attend in person. Other congregation members must attend via Zoom unless they have a special need (i.e., no internet), in which case they may request to attend in person.
