And in these last few years, I've seen you work hard to bite your tongues and do your best to welcome the wiggles.

The kindness and compassion and

hospitality and dedication you offer to one another, and your pastor, and your community is Lord of Life's greatest asset. You all have been excellent adventurous fellow travelers in faith, and without doubt, you all will be a blessing to your next pastor as well.

As our paths diverge, know that you all go with me, for we are joined in Christ. The halo of light around the altar area will stand as a constant reminder of this mystical connection we share with all God's saints.


Women's Virtual Retreat & ASWO Convention Saturday, November 13


Come as you can, stay as long as you're able. We're generally done by 2pm.

Treasurer's report: Undesignated checking: \$3,470.13; Designated Checking: \$5,606.19; Debit Card checking: \$762.15; Savings: \$10,459.26; total assets: \$20,297.73. We saw an increase in tithes. So far this month we are only -\$190.73 in the red. We have \$1000 in invoices to pay. Returned WELCA funds of \$534.16 will go to general funds.
