 - Bovay Scout Ranch McNair Cub Scout Adventure Camp 3450 County Rd 317, Navasota, TX 77868
 - ~75 miles drive from Clear Lake
- Cost: \$50 per person (kids ages 5+ & adults), kids 4 & under are free
 - 3 meals (Sat Lunch+Dinner, Sun Breakfast)
 - Camp plans activities (examples: treasure hunt, archaeological quest, BMX bikes, archery, BB guns, sports field, nature exploration, swimming)
- Required:

- Bicycle and bike helmet
- Book of Faith

- Fishing gear
