K Scott Consults, LLC's Compliance Division consists of Compliance Specialists who have been recognized by the AWCC as Approved Professional Safety Sources (APSS). This division provides compliance assistance with developing, documenting, implementing, and assisting management with maintaining compliance programs to ensure compliance with regulatory agencies, up to and including, but not limited to OSHA, DOT, EPA, AWCC, ADEQ. These compliance programs are required by governmental agencies and are implemented to reduce employee accident and injury, property damage, and subsequently reduce costs due to liability, citations, and fines. On site audits and inspections are conducted by Field Service Representatives (FSRs) who have been recognized by the AWCC, to ensure compliance is maintained. Management reports are generated and presented to corporate to ensure ongoing compliance is maintained.

K Scott Consults, LLC's Training Division consists of instructors who have been recognized by OSHA as Authorized Trainers as having extensive knowledge of regulations and exceptional classroom delivery skills. Instructors in this division have worked in industry applying regulations to their industry, worked alongside production to ensure that safety is integrated in the production process, and not as an "add-on". They possess the ability to identify the regulation in which compliance will be attained, and identifying what training is needed for the specific situation and regulation. Students studying under these instructions are exposed to "hands-on", practical, and real life situations. Courses are designed and prepared to exceed the training requirements for governmental agencies in which businesses are required to comply with, as well as courses that are offered to enhance employees' knowledge, courses that address workplace behaviors as they relate to safety, and courses that empower employees to be safety leaders in their workplaces. Courses are offered at a local training facility where enrollment is open to the public, or on site at a business location, whichever fits the needs and requests of the client.

Scott has over 17 years of investigating access control, workplace injuries and accidents, workers' compensation compensable claims, workplace discrimination, workplace harassment, employee/customer theft, unemployment claims, and product liability claims.
