

The Interdisciplinary Unit for Polish Studies (HIUPS) offers a limited number of PhD scholarships to students registered in the faculty of humanities, arts, education, or social sciences at the University of Haifa and joining the program in Polish studies. The unit invites doctoral candidates in a research track whose work relates to the geographical/cultural area of Poland, to submit applications. The amount of the scholarship will be up to 70,000 ILS per year (up to 3 years).

## An application should include the following materials:

- 1. Cover letter.
- 2. A copy of research proposal, approved or pending approval.
- 3. A concise CV, including contact information.
- 4. Writing example (chapter from the master's thesis / seminar paper / article).
- 5. A work plan detailing the writing stages of the doctorate.
- 6. Two letters of recommendation from scholars in the field, including a letter from a university supervisor. The recommendations should be emailed directly to: <a href="mailto:anvaturi1@gmail.com">anvaturi1@gmail.com</a>

## Scholarship conditions:

- 1. Participation in the Polish Studies Curriculum and activities organized by HIUPS.
- 2. Report on the progress of the research / writing at the end of each semester.
- 3. The general rules of fellowship according to the rules of the University of Haifa.
- 4. Payment of the fellowship in two installments and according to the rules of the University of Haifa.
