

OUR VISION

We hope for a better future, providing the basic fundamental needs for women and children living in extreme conditions







OUR IMPACT

Hope for A Better Future supports women & children in East Africa with their fundamental needs. Our work is a result of deep commitment to these people. Our services directly support women and children towards a better future. Challenges in 2022 has continued to be the Global pandemic of COVID with the many variants that have developed and the affect it has continued to have on the world, countries, communities, people and projects. Fortunately, we have been able to continue our existing programs with good success and managed to support Mikameni village with clean water. However in 2022 the Youth Center remained closed due to lack of participation by the youths during changes in school scheduling.



Empowering women

- SACCOS Savings and Credit Co-Operative Society for the Women of Marangu operates to alleviate poverty within their community, by empowering the Women to utilize their resources to support economic growth.
- In 2022 two SACCOS with over 75 women continues to operate fully. In a continued year where Covid-19 still is impacting it is of great support to the women who previously struggled with income. Growth and the infrastructure is managed by an elective broad of peer. Over 25 small businesses in Marangu are now operating to generate income for these women.



Water project - Mikameni village

- Background: Water supply is poor in Mikameni village, where the preschool is located. In late 2021 investment in the groundwater survey was conducted to initiate the process of providing water through drilling a borehole. This will help provide safe and clean water as well as irrigation for agriculture for over 2,800 people living in the area.
- Phase 1: In 2022 the borehole was drilled and a pump installed together with a 50,000L water tank to supply clean fresh water to the area for health, hygiene and irrigation.
- Phase 2 is planned for 2023 to install 7 water stations in the village for easier access of water to improve overall health of villagers and economic growth and development.





Strengthening children

- Ghona School project: The pre-school in Mikameni Village,
 Tanzania is in full operation, enabling 80 children schooling &
 feeding program of one meal a day. Uniforms were provided
 for new students as well as sweaters for colder days. For many
 children this is the only warm sweater they own. Eggs from the
 chickens gave additional proteins for the children's diet.
 Preschool children also receives health assessments and
 records of health are kept.
- Youth center project: Unfortunately the pandemic hit the youth center very hard. Due to continued restrictions and longer hours for youth in school we have not been able to have the center open in 2022. Continued evaluation in 2022 on how to best utilise the youth center house. We might need to end the rental contract in 2023.





2022 FINANCIALS

Hope for A Better Future's main funding is through private donations. A share of these donations are generated through events held during the year, in 2022 these events were held digital in connection with birthdays and special holidays such as Giving Tuesday and Christmas time. We hope to continue hosting events in 2023.

QUARTER 1 - JANUARY - MARCH

- One hot meal a day. Our feeding program provides a good start to the day for the 80 school children attending Hope For Their Future, in Mikameni Village.
- Children receive continuing education on health and safety guidelines, good hand-washing, keeping distance and good sanitations.
- Mikameni water project survey reviewed with needs outlined and access to clean water source. End of quarter finalising paperwork to get the project started.







QUARTER 2 - APRIL - JUNE

- One hot meal a day Our feeding program provides a good start to the day for the 80 school children attending Hope For Their Future, in Mikameni Village.
- Eggs from chickens continue to provide extra protein to the children's diet and 2 cows are maintained with hope of providing milk in the future.
- Mikameni water project initiated where water tank is built and the drilling of borehole is done during this quarter.







QUARTER 3 - JULY - SEPTEMBER

- Children continue to thrive at "Hope For Their Future". One hot meal a day. Good health and safety guidelines, good hand-washing, keeping distance and good sanitations.
- Our two SACCOS continue to run smoothly within the pandemic environment.
- Mikameni water project completed with 50 000 litre water tank and fresh water tap is provided to the community of approximate 3000 people.
- Travel to Tanzania to follow up on all projects:
 - Main focus Mikameni village to visit water project.
 - SACCOS visit and warm welcome from the women.
 - Pre-school visit and all 80 children.





QUARTER 4 - OCTOBER - DECEMBER

- Children continue to thrive at "Hope For Their Future". One hot meal a day. Good health and safety guidelines, good handwashing, keeping distance and good sanitations.
- Water project is running smoothly. Community is over-joyed about the availability of water and the benefits it gives them.
 Investigations on more water stations are being done. Estimation done for 7 water stations in different locations in the village.
- Christmas donations to children and families was shared which included rice, maze, cooking oil and sugar.
