OUR IMPACT

Hope for A Better Future supports women & children in East Africa with their fundamental needs. Our work is a result of deep commitment to these people. Our services directly support women and children towards a better future. Unfortunately, 2020 was a year that dramatically influenced the whole world. A pandemic affected everyone in some way and we tried to overcome the challenges faced as much as possible. In 2020 we achieved:

Empowering women

- <u>SACCOS Savings and Credit Co-Operative Society:</u> SACCOS for the Women of Marangu operates to alleviate poverty within their community by empowering the Women with utilizing their resources to support economic growth.
- The first SACCOS with 48 women continues to operate fully in 2020. In a year of a crisis it is of great support to the women who previously struggled with income.
- A new SACCOS community bank was founded with an elected board of women and a total of 28 female members. Education were provided months before forming the community bank to prepare the women for taking loans and starting small businesses. Education in various empowering subjects such as business management, health and safety, etc.



OUR IMPACT

Strengthening children

- Ghona School project: The pre-school in Ghona Village, Tanzania is now in full operation, enabling 80 children schooling & feeding program of one meal a day. Uniforms were provided during the year as well as a new kitchen was built. Chickens & cows were also an addition during the year to the school, which will add proteins to they children diet.
- Youth center opening: From January to March the youth center was in full operation with 45 adolescent girls registered to date. Due to Covid-19 all schools and after schools' activities were put on lockdown all the way to July. After that more hours were added to the school days, catching up on missed education, which left few hours for the youth to visit the center. Saturdays became active days where youth could utilize the center for socializing, sports, dance, creative work and also get educational support. New hygiene and social distancing guidelines were implemented.



2020 Financials

Hope for A Better Future's main funding is through private donations. A share of these donations are generated through events held during the year. In March 2020 we hosted a combined Yoga and charity experience, in Marangu Tanzania with focus to generate donations and interest for our newly opened youth center in Marangu, Tanzania.




Activity report 2019

- Schools closed Feeding program Ghona village for 80 children of one meal a day continued. Health and safety guidelines were added to reduce risk of viral spread including keeping social distance and adding extra sanitation/hand washing protocols. Youth center closed.
- Education women group: Preparation for opening of SACCO community bank, business management & health safety.





May:

- Schools closed - Feeding program Ghona village for 80 children of one meal a day. Health and safety guidelines added to keep distance and additional sanitations. Youth center closed.

June:

- Schools closed Feeding program Ghona village for 80 children of one meal a day. Health and safety guidelines added to keep distance and additional sanitations. Youth center closed
- Chicken coop and cow house funded for pre-school in Ghana village



July:

- Youth Center and pre-school reopened July 1 with COVID-19 precautions in place including hand washing stations and social distancing at Youth Center with 4 new table and chairs
- Laying chickens purchased for Ghona pre-school.
- Feeding program Ghona village for 80 children of one meal

August:

- Uniforms for children in Ghona pre-school
