



Disaster can't be prevented, but lack of preparation can!



Disaster Happens Anytime

BLOCKS offers three national disaster readiness certification levels

- Certification at **Bronze Level** indicates the childcare has not just met, but exceeded, state disaster preparedness levels.
- Certification at **Silver Level** indicates the childcare has exceeded 2014 Childcare Development and Block Grant Act requirements.
- Certification at **Gold Level** indicates the childcare has exceeded the 2010 National Commission on Children and Disaster recommendations.

Bronze Level

- Compliant with state laws regarding childcare and disaster preparedness
- Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) updated w/in last 12 months that includes:
 - Evacuation/Relocation, shelter in place, lockdown and reunification plans
 - County assessed hazards, specific medical, child safety, technological issues
 - 3 communications contingency options
- Director/Assistant completion of FEMA IS 36 and IS 366 w/in last 2 years
- EOP training conducted with all staff

Silver Level

- Meet Bronze Level Requirements
- EOP coordinated with local emergency management within last 12 months
- 100% of all staff complete FEMA IS 36 and IS 366 within last two years
- Testing of three communications contingency options during drills
- Parent training/disaster preparedness information session conducted
- Shelter in Place Drill conducted
- Lock down drill conducted

Gold Level

- Meet Silver Level Requirements
- Test of evacuation/reunification plans (with transportation)
- Continuity operation plan drafted
