Please do not pour motor oil or chemicals into our storm drains. When materials such as motor oil enter into the retention ponds, it causes a lot of issues, in particular with the pond treatments. Thank you for disposing of these materials properly.

Last summer we installed a smart meter for our electrical (required) at the entrance only to find the current system was non-compliant. This summer we are working on both our sprinkler system and tree replacement program.

We currently have six trees scheduled to be removed. Once this is completed we will review our budget and evaluate what is next.
