School Bus Safety - Think First!

(or lose your license for up to a year)

Recently, we have seen vehicles going around school buses with their red flashing lights on picking up students. This is extremely dangerous as students are often running to catch the bus.

Many do not know that if you are convicted of passing a stopped school bus with flashing lights and the stop arm extended, it will result in the suspension of your driver's license, typically for a minimum of one year (Illinois Rules of the Road page 41).

Fences – Last year in Spring 2022, we asked all homeowners to take a look at the condition of their fence. Keeping fences in good shape helps maintain our property values. There are several fences that are in need of repair in TECA. We are asking for these to be repaired in Spring 2023.

Tree Branch Trimming–Sidewalks – In several areas we have tree branches (parkway and/or yard) blocking the sidewalk(s). We need to have these pruned. Winter is an ideal time to prune trees as the trees are dormant. Please take a minute to check out your sidewalk area. If your tree(s) need to be pruned, now is time.

Project Butterfly – The Association is working with a couple of local resources to encourage residents to plant a shrub or bush that will attract butterflies this spring. We will have more details at our annual meeting. In the interim, please think about where a plant could go in your yard that attracts butterflies.
