Dues Increase for 2026 – Invoice Included

For the past 20 years, the Tuttle Estates Community Association has managed the community budget without increasing dues. Earlier this year, the Board closely monitored rising expenses to determine whether we could maintain the current rate. By midsummer, it became clear that an increase was necessary, and we sought resident input through a community survey. Thank you to everyone who participated—your feedback was invaluable.

At the November Board meeting, the Board approved an annual dues increase to **\$240** for 2026. Our goal is to maintain this level for several years while continuing to provide responsible financial stewardship. Even with this adjustment, Tuttle Estates remains one of the lowest-cost HOAs in the surrounding area.

Yard Signage and Facade Maintenance

We'd like to provide a reminder about two exterior standards within Tuttle Estates. First, the Board has received several questions regarding yard signage.

Under our community covenants, yard signs are not permitted, with the exception of real estate signs. When the guidelines were originally written, celebratory signs—such as graduation or birth announcements—were not common. To support today's traditions while maintaining the intent of our rules, we ask that any short-term congratulatory signs be placed close to your front porch and displayed for no more than two weeks. Political signs, contractor signs, and service-related signage remain prohibited.

The second item concerns maintenance of home façades. A number of homes have brick veneers or front elevations showing visible deterioration, including cracking or missing sections. Consistent with the association's codes and covenants, these elements must be properly maintained and repaired. If your home requires attention—especially on the street-facing façade—please plan to complete the necessary restoration this spring. Thank you for helping us maintain the appearance and value of our community.
