How to Groom Your Horse

Put Them In Order


- 1. Use a curry comb to break up all the dried mud and dirt. Use a shedding blade to get rid of excess hair in the spring when the horse is shedding.
- 2. Starting at the neck, use the hard/medium brush to lift dirt to the surface and flick it away.
- 3. Use a soft brush to polish the horse's coat and smooth the hair and distribute the coat's natural oils.
- 4. Use a hair brush, comb or hard brush to tend to the horse's mane.
- 5. Use a hair brush, comb or hard brush to tend to the horse's tail.
