A Plan to Unite Americans by John G. Curry

In my opinion, our society, economy, and government are dysfunctional, and hazardous to our safety, happiness, and peace. If you disagree with that assessment, then you might think it is a waste of your time to read further.

We can directly solve community and individual problems and create opportunities, and we can increase our safety, happiness, and peace, through working together. I'm just a community-minded person with common sense and experience with cooperative economics. I'm also a retired Chicago firefighter, who learned strategies for protecting life and property, and for solving problems before, during, and after emergencies.

I think the best and most effective way that we can work together, in America, is by creating an equally owned national cooperative economic network of at least 100 million people who pool \$100 each to share more than \$10 billion dollars of economic leverage and the power created by so much money and so many people with different knowledge, skills, and resources, etc., working together using a custom-designed dynamic communication system that we create. We can proceed this way:

Steps of My Plan:

- 1. Raise initial funds (\$5,000,000 \$100,000,000).
- 2. Create a simple communication system for use in setting up the network.
- 3. Choose initial attorneys, accountants, etc.
- 4. Form the network as a corporation, so that many persons can legally act as one person; and write temporary amendable bylaws.
- 5. Enroll the membership, create databases, fund network by selling each member 1 share of stock for \$100. Each member is only allowed to own 1 share, so we are equal in ownership. Members will most likely need to be adult citizens or permanent residents of the USA. And junior members as young as 13 years old might be included, if legal, or at least in deliberations.
- 6. Create the custom-designed dynamic communication system that facilitates us resolving and then acting as one. Select officers, managers, and employees; and finalize bylaws.
- 7. Start working together to solve community and individual problems and create opportunities; and start gaining control of our society, economy, and government.

How long might it take for us to get to Step 7? That depends on you, me, and millions of other people in the USA finding value in this effort and acting to help it succeed. It might also depend on millions of people in other Countries, who see the indirect value in our success, and their support.
