

POSITION DESCRIPTION: Cantata Director at South Santiago Lutheran Church (SSLC)

Accountability: Reports to Senior Pastor

Ministry Responsibilities Summary: SSLC Cantata Director stewards the musical gifts of the congregation through two cantata per year (once during Lent and once during Advent).

Time Commitment: One rehearsal a week for 6 weeks, a dress rehearsal, and up to two performances per cantata. \$450 will be paid for each cantata performed (includes planning and rehearsal time). Cantata director is responsible for submitting a time card after each cantata is complete.

Primary Duties:

- Organize and direct choir cantatas, provide rehearsals and actively recruit new voices to enhance the choir. Produce an Easter and a Christmas Cantata annually.
- Nurture and encourage the sharing of musical gifts by members including instrumentalists and singers.

Job Qualifications

Skills & Competencies:

- Strong communication and organizational skills.
- Ability to lead and direct choir.

Personal Qualities:

- Positive and encouraging

Work Environment/Method/Styles: Can Work Independently, Can Work with a Team. Remote work is authorized for planning, Cantata director will need to be present Sunday mornings when choir rehearses and performs

Desired Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Leadership, Wisdom, Musical talents.

In the event the congregation leadership opts to move in a different staffing direction, the Cantata Director will be given a minimum of four weeks' notice of elimination of position. This position description will be reviewed and signed annually by the employee and SSLC Council President.
