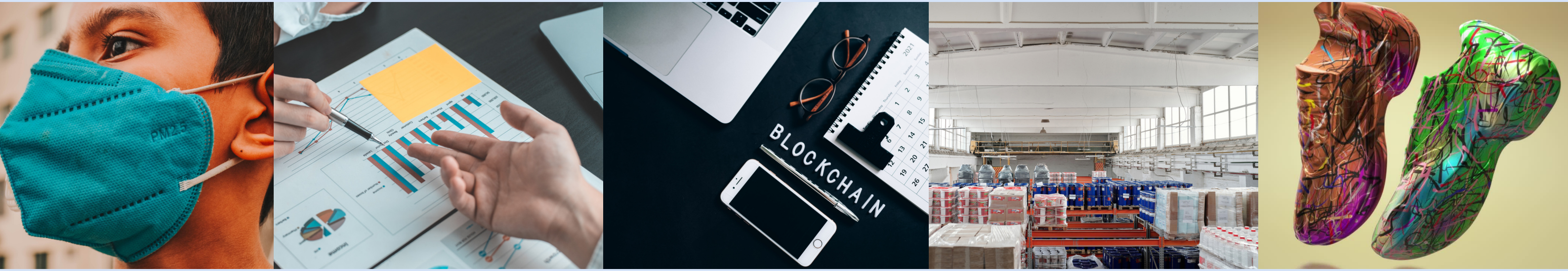


OPEN FORUM - POST PANDEMIC CHALLENGE: NEW ECONOMY AND TECHNOLOGIES
