

Call for Entries

You are invited to enter the 50th Hopkinsville Art Guild Pennyroyal Art Exhibition held at Hopkinsville Community College Auditorium Building Art Gallery, 720 North Drive, Hopkinsville, Kentucky. The exhibit will be on display from October 2, through October 24, 2021.

Categories - Artists may submit a total of **three** works in the exhibition in any of these 6 categories.

- 1. Drawing (Pencil, Charcoal, Ink, Pastels)
- 2. Water Media (Acrylic, Watercolor)
- 3. Oil Media
- Mixed Media/3-D (Fiber, Collage, Experimental, Pottery, Sculpture, Jewelry, Wood turning/carving,
- **5. Photography** (may be digitally edited)
- **6.** Celebrating 50 Special category for celebrating 50 years of the Pennyroyal Art Exhibition Submissions may be created in any media, 2D or 3D and entered in other categories. They could be a literal representation of fifty items or images representing 50 years ago (1971) or 50 years in the future. They could be a concept commonly symbolized by the number fifty, such as golden anniversary. They will be judged on merit and appropriate representation of theme.

Eligibility - Artists 14 years or older residing in Kentucky or surrounding states may enter. All work must be original, have been completed within the last 3 years and not previously entered in the Pennyroyal Art Exhibition. Entries must be appropriate for public display, with no nudity allowed. Needle work must be original design.

Entry Fee -Artist may enter up to 3 works for the following non-refundable entry fees.

Hopkinsville Art Guild members entry fee \$15 for first piece, \$10 for second, \$5 for third entry. Non Members entry fee \$25 for first piece, \$20 for second, \$15 for third entry. Young at Art - age 14 - 21 fee \$10 for first piece, \$5 for second, \$3 for third entry

Cash or Checks accepted. Checks should be made payable to Hopkinsville Art Guild.

Delivery - Completed entry forms and fees must be delivered with the artwork on Friday, Oct. 1 or Saturday, Oct. 2 from 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. to a Hopkinsville Art Guild member at the Hopkinsville Community College Auditorium Bldg. Art Gallery, 720 North Drive, Hopkinsville. No early or late work delivery will be accepted. Hopkinsville Community College employees are not involved with the art exhibition.

Framing and Size Limitations - All 2D work must be strongly framed, securely wired, ready for hanging, and weigh no more than 40 pounds. Saw-tooth hangers will not be accepted as they cannot be hung. Sculpture and other three-dimensional art may not weigh more than 40 pounds. Freestanding sculptures requiring special mounting are not accepted. Top heavy or unstable work will be disqualified.

Awards - Cash awards totaling \$3,500 will be determined by the Juror

- John Hall III Best of Show (\$500) May come from any category, selected by the juror as an outstanding example of craftsmanship and creativity.
- **First, Second, Third Place and Honorable Mention** in each media category. The total awards will be based on entry fees and sponsorships.
- **Purchase, Merit and Memorial Awards** will be presented. Artist may decline to be in Purchase award category. Purchase award amounts will be determined before delivery of work for exhibition.
- **People's Choice Award** of \$200 is given by United Southern Bank, will be selected based on visitors to the exhibit casting votes for their favorite piece of art in the exhibition.
- **Daedalus Award** of \$300 will reflect an effort to attain an ideal balance between craft and art. It is designed to advocate for artists using innovative techniques and materials.

Insurance - Signature on entry form constitutes agreement by the entrant that there shall be no liability on the part of the Hopkinsville Art Guild or any members or sponsors for loss, damage, or destruction of any works. Insurance of artwork is the sole responsibility of the participating entrant.

Sales - Sales must be arranged between the artist and the buyer. No commissions will be charged. All work must have a price listed for insurance calculations even if the work is not for sale. Artist's email address and phone number may be placed on wall cards if desired for ease of contact for sales.

Removal of Work - All entered work must remain on display until the end of the exposition and must be picked up only on Sunday, October 24 from 3:00 to 3:30. Early removal may result in exclusion from future exhibitions. Art work will be released only to the artist or others given written permission to pick up artwork.

About the Juror:

Kell Alexander Black was born in Atlanta, Georgia. He earned a BA in piano and German at the State University of New York, College at Fredonia, studied harpsichord and Baroque performance practice at the Wiener Hochschule für Musik in Vienna, Austria, and was awarded the MFA in drawing and sculpture from the University of Connecticut, Storrs. He began teaching at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, Tennessee, in 1993 and retired in 2008 as head of the Art Department. He received numerous awards, including a National Endowment for the Arts/Southern Art Federation Individual Artist's Grant in Drawing. He has exhibited his graphic work throughout the United States and Switzerland. He is also active as a paper engineer, and his work is in the permanent collection of Tennessee State Museum. He has published three books on paper engineering through Ivy Press in the UK. He spends his days walking his dog, making art, and translating a book for his wife's birthday.
