

the Archbishops' Young Leaders Award is a fully resourced leadership and character education programme designed to both enhance and form part of the Post 16 curriculum. It offers an exciting opportunity for our young people to:

Key Worker

What is a key worker?

Your key worker is a member of staff selected within the first 6 weeks of you being with us. This is the person you naturally gravitate towards and feel comfortable with. For your initial first weeks our senior mental health lead will act as your key worker until you are ready to transition.

What help can they give me?

Your key worker will act as your mentor, you will complete a minimum of 1 session per week which is scheduled into your time table, here you will set goals and check in to see how the week has gone. You may which to talk though areas you loved or areas where you feel you need further support. Your key worker can support you though breaks and dinners if you feel particularly anxious during this time of the day.




Growth Mindset Mission


