HAPPY TO BE OF SERVICE: One of the elements which is common to our morning

worship services (and to which we often give little thought) is the use of brief hymn-like songs referred to collectively as service music. In our 1982 Hymnal, all service music is gathered into a separate section in the front; and each piece is assigned a hymn number preceded by the letter "S", to differentiate it from a potential hymn with the same number. [For example, service-music selection "S 124" is a version of the Sanctus, whereas general-hymn "124" is the Epiphany standard, "What star is this, with beams so bright" – not the same thing at all.]

In the Preface to our 1982 Hymnal, service music is identified as "musical settings of Prayer Book texts." For a typical Sunday-morning service during the Season after Pentecost (our current liturgical season), we commonly use three pieces of service music: a Gloria in excelsis (or other canticle, such as Canticle 13 [S 236], which we've used for some months now); a Sanctus [S 125]; and a Fraction Anthem [S 154]. We've sung each of these selections during many liturgical seasons; they are familiar to us, and we are comfortable with them. [Uh-oh...] However, music directors are warned repeatedly that familiarity and comfort lead to complacency; so that those elements which should be uplifting and inspiring in worship become simply matters of rote. We are therefore encouraged to replace these selections regularly.

Several years ago, I tried my hand at composing a Mass whose sections would be brief, easy to learn, and memorable enough so that our congregation could sing some of these sections each week as our service music. The results were only partially successful; but I did manage to extract a Gloria and a Sanctus, and cobble together a Fraction Anthem, which might be useful to us. We gave them a trial run a few years back; but I've tweaked them a bit, and plan to reintroduce them during the last two Sundays in July. As we've done with other unfamiliar music, we'll have a short "singing school" just prior to the 8:30 and 11:00 services on July 21 to go over the Gloria before singing it in the service proper. Then we'll do the same thing on July 28 with the Sanctus and the Fraction Anthem. Hopefully by the first Sunday in August, you will be familiar enough with these to use them in our services for the remainder of the Season after Pentecost. Please let me know how these versions work out for you; and thank you for your continuing support of the music ministry at St. Matthew's.


