Nevada as a Sanctuary State for Trans Surgeries on Children

1. **WHO is in need of help?** Impressionable and vulnerable young people.
2. **HOW does the downward spiral start?** Baited by a trap of belonging, attention getting and the feeling of being someone ' special ', or affiliation in a “special group”. This social pressure can occur in online settings, social circles and definitely at a public tax funded school.
3. **WHAT'S the harm?** Irreversible procedures and/or hormone interference with long lasting or permanent unwanted effects, such as infertility, blood clots, vaginal atrophy, loss of ability to breast feed. Numbers tell the story best- From January 2019 to December 2023, 13,994 minor patients received gender-transition treatments. **Currently, over 27,000 Detransitioners communicate in the Reddit forums.**¹
4. **How to help?**

Contact NV Governor Lombardo *(or your state as it pertains) to request similar legislation to legally protect parents who resist procedures performed on their minor children, protect parents' right to know if their child is changing clothes at school or going by a different name or pronoun that their genetic sex and legal name. Laws should safeguard vulnerable minors* from sexual modification.

- *Pay attention to the books, media, entertainment and games your loved ones are consuming.*

What the Reddit data tells us about the cycle of trans to detrans

76% of detransitioners in the Reddit survey are female. 60% started identifying as trans when they were 13-16 years old.

The general trend observed from these survey results is that most detransitioners start identifying as trans at 13-16 (puberty), ID for several years (into early adulthood), try medical transition for a relatively short amount of time (a few months to a few years) and then detransition around the time brain development has matured (25).

Let's look at the list of 22 states which have caught up to a number of nations operating in wisdom on this topic, ensuring protections for the youth effected by this social contagion to negate one's fundamental biology. Five other states have laws which limit procedures permitted on minors.

Currently Nevada has not yet passed legislation to protect minors. In fact our legislators have put forth a bill to protect practioners performing on minors during this 2025 session.
