Lesley has been looking at alternative suppliers for our meals, to improve taste and quality of meals served at the Centre's.

Everyone at the meeting had the choice of meal types and preferences to influence the next menu which will run from May to July at both Centre's.

It was agreed to reduce the menu choices to make it more concise and easier to choose weekly options. From the next menu, there will be a choice of 4 meals plus a jacket potato option.

The group has chosen the following menu options for May to July – Sausage and mash, chicken korma with rice, macaroni cheese, lasagne and jacket potatoes with a weekly filling.

Puddings were discussed with people offering their favourites, including cheesecake, fruit salad, trifle.

The group gave examples of activities they would like to see at the Centre in the future:

- Nature themes activities Bird feeders (different types), bug hotels, birdwatching, walks in the local area.
- Themed days Jackie has fancy dress and decorative items for a Mexican Theme Day. We will plan this for the coming weeks. Taco's can me made as part of the activity for this.
- Crafts / Activities rock painting, wicker working, model aeroplane kits / airfix models, woodwork crafts.
 A movie afternoon, relaxation afternoon and afternoon tea were suggested.
- Music musical memories sessions (favourite songs and meanings for each person), musical sessions and entertainers.
- Items for the Centre's: Train set Lesley to look at sourcing and PAT testing requirements.
- Outing's Transportation needs to be identified that is suitable for all.
 Local bus companies may have accessible minibuses. Bassetlaw
 Action Centre have a bus to hire but it is costly so alternatives to be
 looked at. Moxons?, GBD travel? taxi firms?
 Suggestions for outings included a picnic at Langold Lakes, a visit to
 Barrow Hill,
- Visiting speakers Mr Straw's House visits were on hold when last contacted but we will retry this, model aeroplane club.

It was agreed that an activities timetable would benefit the Centre's. It was suggested a rolling 6-7 week timetable that incorporates the chiropodist visits would be the most suitable. Lesley will discuss this with Vicki and a timetable will be drawn up.
