

RESOLUTION NO. 2027-02
A RESOLUTION OF GASQUET COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE
2026 DEL NORTE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the GASQUET COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT has exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment, and the GASQUET, CA economy; and

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, a coalition of DEL NORTE COUNTY stakeholders with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies to be implemented within each partner's identified capabilities, within the COUNTY OF DEL NORTE; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating, and revising this strategy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the GASQUET COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT:

- 1.) Adopts in the 2026 DEL NORTE COUNTY Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- 1.) Will use the adopted and approved portions of the 2026 DEL NORTE COUNTY Hazard Mitigation Plan to guide pre and post disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.
- 2.) Will coordinate the strategies identified in the 2026 DEL NORTE COUNTY Hazard Mitigation Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its authority.
- 3.) Will continue its support of the on-going mitigation efforts and continue to participate in the plan maintenance and support as described by the 2026 DEL NORTE COUNTY Hazard Mitigation Plan.
