**Criteria for Judging Applications**

The scholarship committee has prescribed these criteria for judging all scholarship applications. The following headings should be weighted by the associated percentage:

- Overall presentation-----15%
  - a) Neatness 5%
  - b) Accuracy (spelling, grammar, etc. 5%
  - c) Following directions 5%
- Academics-----20%
- Extracurricular Activities-----10%
- SCCAHA Involvement-----20%
- Zoom Interview-----20%
- Career Plans Essay-----15%
