

NEW FREEZE PREVENTION TOOL EXCITES GROWERS

NY peach grower Harry Raby was skeptical but Tanya Reid finally persuaded him to **BioWash** his blooming peaches before the 19 F. freeze.

Background: The 2011-warm winter caused early blooming. Fruit growers expected extensive losses when the freeze was forecast.
