PIONEER CHURCH CONTINUING RESTORATION GRANT APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that the Emery Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, July 8, 2026, at 6:45 p.m. at the Emery Town Hall, 65 North Center Street, Emery, Utah.

The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comments regarding Emery Town's proposed application for grant funding to continue the restoration and preservation of the historic Pioneer Church. The proposed project may include architectural preservation, structural improvements, accessibility enhancements, and other restoration activities necessary to preserve the historic integrity and public use of the facility.

All interested persons are invited to attend and provide comments regarding the proposed grant application, project scope, community benefits, and any potential impacts.

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), individuals needing special accommodations, including auxiliary communicative aids and services, during this hearing should notify the Emery Town Recorder at least three (3) business days prior to the hearing by calling (435) 286-2417.
