Columbus City SC Fee Coverage:

Columbus City SC fee schedule is competitive to other clubs located in Central Ohio. We strive to make all fees included in the fee structure so no additional fees will be added at the end of the season. Below is a list of items that is covered in the Fee schedule.

- Registration fees and carding of all players through U.S. Club Soccer.
- Registration of team in leagues (OCL, OSSSL, COPL, MDL, GLA, NPL GLC etc.) and league tournaments.
- All Referee fees (Note: Team Admins will be reimbursed for all league games. Team Admins may request prior or after leagues games.).
- Registration and fees for all tournaments (Tournaments, College Showcases, State Cup, and League Tournaments).
- Coaches' Salaries, fees, travel expenses, meals and car mileage.
- Annual registration of all teams through TeamSnap App.
- Home Fields for training, setup and game reservations.
- Outdoor & Indoor Training fields (2X-Training sessions per week) and (Winter Training).
- Columbus City SC Administrative and operating costs (Staff, branding, networks, and other club promoting costs (i.e. Website etc.).
- Goalkeeper training.
- College Pamphlets and Roster information distributed to Coaches for College Showcases.
- Professional licensed coaches for each team.
- Veo Video: Teams will have access to the Veo video which can be used for recruitment as well as video analysis for games. These games will be shared with families to use for highlight videos as well as to share with family members.

Please note: Access to Veo equipment may vary and will be used for our HS players who have priority and subsequent younger teams may use upon availability.

Uniforms: Columbus City SC's uniform package cost's approximately \$300.00 which includes 2 pairs of shorts and socks, home and away game jerseys, 2 training shirts, warm up top and team bag.

Sibling Discount: There is a \$250 multi-child discount for subsequent siblings for ages U11 and up, a \$100 multi-child discount for siblings in the U8-U10 age groups.

Cancellation of Tournaments: In the event that a tournament is canceled by the Tournament Director, Columbus City SC will do its best to replace that event when possible.

Additional Tournaments: Each team will have designated 4 tournaments for the year (Families will know which 4-tournament this will cover). Any additional tournament will be provided to the families prior to the season beginning. All additional tournaments must be approved by the coach and club director and paid prior to the event. Families will be given a cost per player at the beginning of the year and between coach and families will determine if they attend any additional tournaments.

Columbus City SC Fee Agreement & Finance Policies

Upon accepting an offer from Columbus City SC, indicates an agreement to the fee schedule listed above and the terms provided below. Club fees can be paid in advance and will be due at the 1st of each month. Any late fees received after 7-day maybe subject to an additional \$25 late fee.

Failure to pay any player's club fees within 14 days of the due date, will cause a player to be removed from being able to participate in training, games or tournaments until payment is received. If there is any valid reason (Loss of income, or any other financial strain) for a missed payment, please contact your coach and club administrator for guidance and possible flexibility to this rule.

If a family or player requests to be released from the club, they will not be refunded any current payments, but will be stopped from any future payments. In rare situations such as injury, moving or any other valid proof to leave the club, a pro-rate amount will be funded back to the family. This may also include the request to return all and any uniforms to be used by any family that may be in need of a uniform due to financial hardships.

Any requests, transfers, withdrawals must be presented in writing to info@columbuscitysc.com. Any communication to coaches will not be considered as you will need to submit your request in writing.

Code of Conduct

Columbus City SC believes the growth of the player includes the actions of parents on the pitch and at home. At this young age, we strive to have a positive experience for all and know positive encouragement as a player grows is the most effective way for them to learn and become a better player. Below is a list of Columbus City SC Parent and Fan Expectations:

- **Positivity:** Cheer on your child and team and give words of encouragement.
- **Refrain from coaching your child in Practice or Games.** This may go contrary to what the coach is trying to teach in position and the game. ***Parents may be communicated by the coach if it becomes a disruption.***
- **Respect the referees:** We ask all parents and fans to provide positive interactions with the referees. We have seen a significant decrease in referees and Columbus City SC strives to have positive relationships with our referees.
- Learn the game of soccer. This can help you understand the rules but also help teach your child.
- **24-hour Cooling Period:** If you have any frustrations towards your coach, we ask that you do not reach out until it has been at least 24 hours from the game.
- **You are a representative of Columbus City SC.** Be a role model of your player and our team when at events.
- **Respectful Communication:** Communicate with coaches, staff, and Directors in a respectful and professional manner. Please be open to what they are saying in each situation.
