_____ Testing and College Credit:

I understand that AP is a registered trademark of The College Board, and that by taking a Pre-AP or AP English Language course, I am in no way guaranteed to receive college credit. College credit is awarded by each individual college or university that sets its own credit awarding policies. Furthermore, the AP English Language test score will be one of the determining factors in receiving college credit. The AP English Language test will not be given as part of this course. If your student desires to take the test, there will be a fee for the test to cover what the testing center charges. However, Blaze University will not be charging any fee for the test. Blaze University cannot guarantee any specific result of the AP English Language test.

_____ Code of Conduct:

Blaze University requires students to be respectful of everyone at all times. It is also expected that students attend regularly, avoid all forms and all appearances of cheating, obey basic classroom rules, and participate in homework and class projects. If a student or parent fails to be respectful and honor such basic expectations, it could result in the disenrollment of a student from any Blaze University class at any time. Payment and Refund Policy:

The Pre-AP English language class is a full school-year long class costing \$450.

A \$25 deposit is required to hold a place for your student in class. On July 1 a second installment of \$25 is required to continue to hold the spot, meaning by July 1, a total of \$50 will be required to secure a place in this class.

On the first day of class, the remaining balance for just the first semester, which will be \$175, is due. The entire second semester payment of \$225 is due December 1 or before. Payment may be made by cash or check. We do not accept credit cards at this time.

Unfortunately, payment plans cannot be accommodated.

The Payment Schedule:

First day of class	\$175	Which brings the total paid to \$225, equaling the full first semester, half of the year's payment
December 1	\$225	This completes the full year's payment of \$450

By signing this form, parents agree to pay for the full school year. If payments are not made at any time according to this payment schedule, Blaze University can disenroll the student from the class. Space in class is only guaranteed when payment and registration paperwork is received on time.

Refund Policy:

Full refunds will be given until July 15 of that school year. After that time, unfortunately, no refunds will be given.
