

Address: 7220 NW 101st Terrace, KC MO 64153.

Located in Tiffany Springs, less than a mile east from the Embassy Suites Hotel

Cost: Free

We will tour the National Weather Service - AWC (Aviation Weather Center) which is a 7/24/365 facility providing weather information to all commercial airlines and private pilots covering an area from Guam in the Pacific to the mid-Atlantic Ocean area.

This is a federal facility, so some type of government issued ID will be required for all attendees (driver's license, passport) This facility has both live security guards and automated security cameras, so your old cars will be safe.

Those of you with mobility issues will enjoy this tour as there are no steps nor elevators, and not much walking will be required.

Afterwards we'll head to Granite City Food and Brewery located in Zona Rosa just off Barry Road for lunch.






