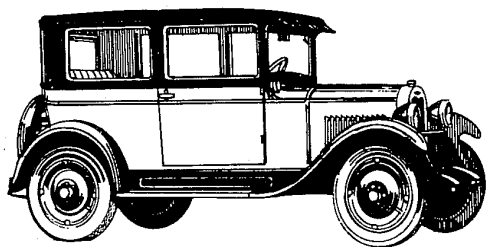

3. Select the red "Sign Up" box for the job(s) you would like to help with and then choose the "Submit and Sign-up" red button at the bottom of the signup screen.

4. On the confirmation page, you will be asked to provide your name, email and phone number. If you would like to sign up yourself and your spouse for a job, change the quantity to "2" and in the comments section, add your first names.

5. Once you have signed-up, you will receive an email confirmation of the date, time and job. We will also send a reminder email to all volunteers on May 30th, the Saturday before the meet starts.

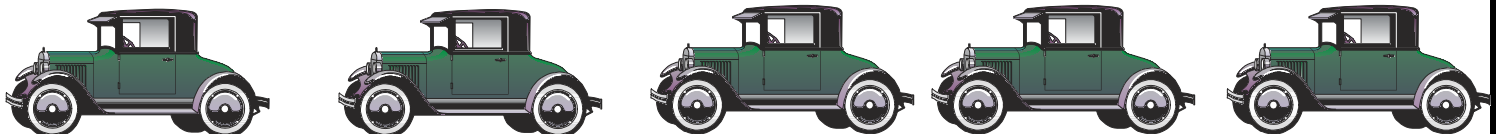

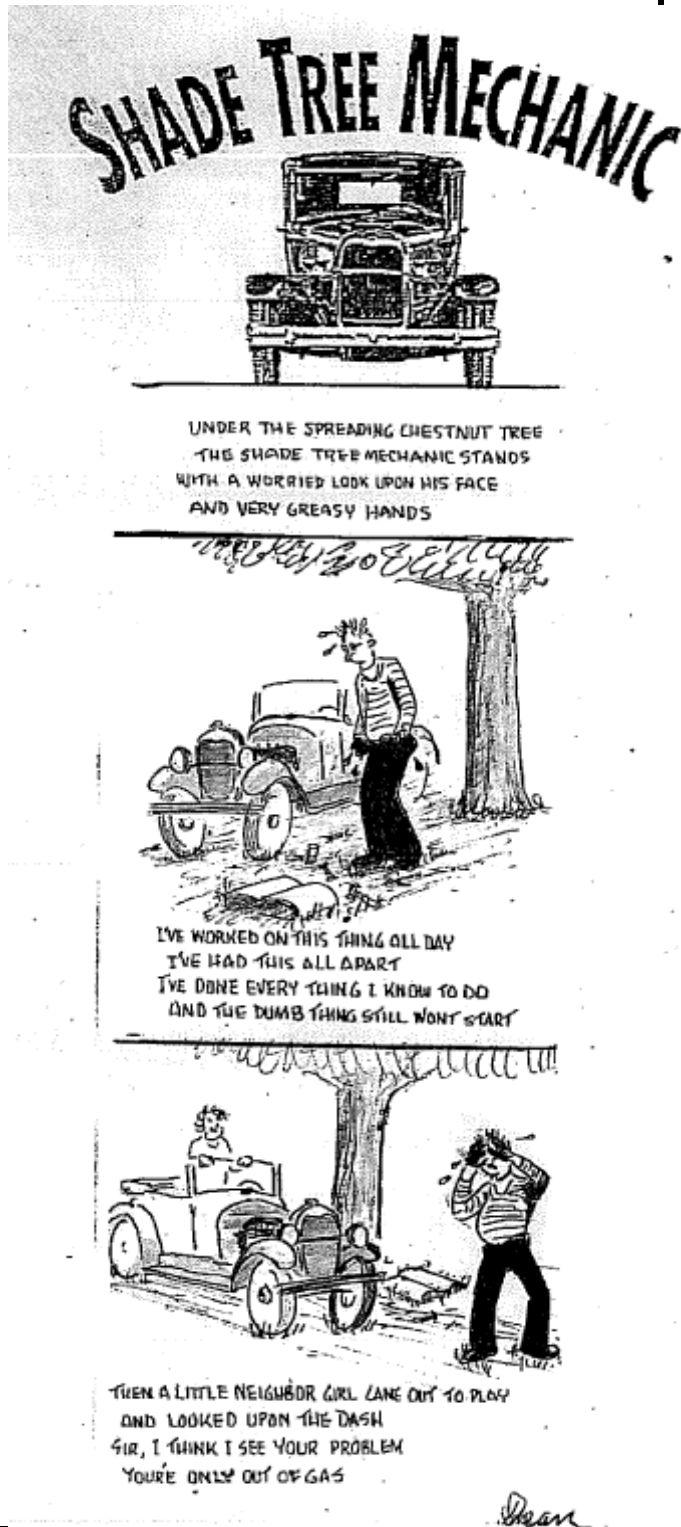
