## Jim's technical tip

Rattles Under the Hood

Very few things are as annoying as a persistent rattle under the hood while you drive your Model A. Of course it stops when you pull over and look under there!

Here are some things that I have found over the years can sound like a rattle under the hood:

The radiator support rods. They come loose at the radiator or at the firewall.

The engine pans. Just one loose bolt/nut can rattle like crazy (hard to find).

Hood support/prop brackets. The ones that "fold in" will rattle if closed all the way; open it back up  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to separate the halves from touching.

Brake rods. Jiggle them by hand. You may need to install some of the oversize clevis pins to tighten things back up, or replace the return/anti-rattle springs.

Tools and things under the seat. (I found a large screwdriver once in my side curtain pan, way in the back, that was causing a rattle that I chased for 2 years!)

I hope this helps you track down that annoying rattle. In a future Tech Tip, I will cover potential sources of other annoying noises in your car. Until then, "Have a Model A Day!" Jim

# 10th Annual Model A Day

As all of you know by now, 2020 has been a very unusual year and it has forced a reevaluation of all of our normal activities. Most of the Model A get togethers for the year have been cancelled and it has left a void in our lives as we have gotten to know such great people in the hobby. Model A Day at the Gilmore was also cancelled to protect the health of all Model A Hobbyists. Our theme for this years event was First Responders which is very appropriate with what is happening right now and this theme will carry over to next years event.

Each Year Model A Day generated roughly one third of the Model A Ford Foundation, Inc(MAFFI) operating budget which includes operating the Model A Museum at Gilmore. With the cancellation of Model A Day we have a shortcoming of operating income for 2020. We have come up with a goal of \$30,000 to satisfy this shortfall.

WE THOUGHT IT WOULD BE BEST IF WE COULD COME UP WITH A WAY FOR ALL OF THE NATIONAL CLUB (MARC AND MAFCA) CHAPTERS TO PARTICIPATE AND IN DOING SO WOULD MAKE EACH CLUB'S OUTLAY REASONABLE. THERE ARE OVER 250 MAFCA CHAPTERS AND OVER 175 MARC CHAPTERS ALONG WITH SOME INTERNATIONAL CHAPTERS. IF THE GOAL WAS SET TO HAVE EACH CLUB PUT FORTH \$100 WE WOULD EASILY ACHIEVE THE GOAL. WE WOULD THEN COME UP WITH A NOBLE WAY OF RECOGNIZING THOSE CLUBS THAT HELPED TO GET US THROUGH THIS TOUGH TIME BEFORE NEXT YEAR'S EVENT.

THERE WILL BE MULTIPLE WAYS FOR CLUB'S TO PARTICIPATE. WE WILL HAVE IT SET UP ON OUR WEB PAGE ALONG WITH SENDING OUT EMAIL BLASTS TO ALL KNOWN CLUB CONTACTS. ADDITIONALLY, WE WILL TRY TO PROMOTE ON BOTH CLUB'S FACEBOOK PAGES AND IN THEIR NATIONAL MAGAZINES WITH A GOAL OF HAVING CONTRIBUTIONS SENT IN BY THE END OF THE YEAR. INDIVIDUALS ARE WELCOME TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS AS WELL IF THEY WISH.




