





Tech Tip for May 2010

If you haven't had a Bendix bolt break off yet you most likely will, eventually. It will end up in the flywheel housing and if not removed it can wind up jamming the flywheel or ring gear, thus locking up the engine. One method to remove the broken bolt is to attach a small magnet to a piece of flexible wire or tubing. Remove the starter and fish the magnet and wire into the flywheel housing and try to pull the bolt out. This usually works. If not then remove the flywheel inspection plate located between the flywheel housing and oil pan. Remove the three bolts holding the inspection plate to the flywheel housing and slide the plate off. It's a tight fit. Fish around with your magnet and see if you can pull the bolt out that way.

Once you retrieve the bolt you will next have to repair the Bendix. These are special bolts and tabbed washers. They can be ordered from your favorite Model A supply house. I also have them in my inventory. There are two sizes. A smaller 5/16-24 bolt and a larger 3/8-24 bolt. The smaller ones are usually the ones that brake. You will have to have the correct size to make the repair. There are two different styles of bolts in the set. Replace them both while you are at it. Bend the tab on the washers up against the head of the bolts to keep them from turning.

If you are on 12 volts using a 6 volt starter the chances of breaking these bolts is much higher. It is almost certain if your Bendix uses the smaller bolts. A little preventative action here is a good idea. Inspect your Bendix. If you have the small bolts consider replacing the Bendix with the type with the larger bolts or better yet install one of the newer barrel style type starter drives. Both are also available from your favorite Model A parts house.
