
tune and have been a big advocate since.

As we do this, we inevitably experience conflict, because we don't all think and feel exactly the same on every issue. This leads to a spirited debate, which is important, because only when we've all really expressed what we hear from God, can we make a truly informed decision/commitment. Once the commitment is made, we have to get to work and keep each other accountable to the decision made, so that we can achieve Results, which ultimately should bless the people of God, the MCCR, and give Glory to God!

Another teaching of AP that we are working on is having a Rallying Cry, something that we all work on for 3-6 months. Our current Rallying Cry has been to schedule the Night of Healing through 2023, and as of writing this letter, we have the Night of Healing scheduled until October 2023... just 2 months to go! In the past, it wasn't uncommon to finish a Night of Healing one month and not have one scheduled for the next. Now, because we are focused and learning how to hold each other accountable to a shared goal, we are becoming




