Once the commitment is made, we have to get to work and keep each other accountable to the decision made, so that we can achieve Results, which ultimately should bless the people of God, the MCCR, and give Glory to God!

Another teaching of AP that we are working on is having a Rallying Cry, something that we all work on for 3-6 months. Our current Rallying Cry has been to schedule the Night of Healing through 2023, and as of writing this letter, we have the Night of Healing scheduled until October 2023... just 2 months to go! 
