Sophomore year I pledged Phi Alpha Kappa Christian fraternity and discerned a call to ministry with the help of two great pastors. Pastor John and Pastor Tom became my heroes. Their preaching, leadership, council, and prayer led me to want to be just like them. In a deep way, Pastor Tom became my big brother and Pastor John was like a father. The University Reformed Church

and Phi Alpha Kappa gave me such a great community and sense of purpose. And this was no accident, as Pastor Tom's desire was to create a Christian culture for us students. In fact one of his youth group series was on Christian Community, and one of the weeks he had a couple of young men who were living in "community" and "living single for the Lord." I don't remember what they said, but I remember wanting to know more about them. Eventually I made it over to their house, and was exposed to the

Charismatic Renewal, as they were a part of what's now called the Word of Life, an ecumenical, charismatic, covenant community. I attended Alpha through their college outreach (UCO) University Christian Outreach and experienced Charismatic prayer for the first time. After this I was


