If you have a physical disability, we promise to do all we can to understand your needs and how you want to be supported. We will ask you, we will check with you and we will ensure you are treated with dignity and respect.



If you are someone who has Autism or any other Special Education Need (SEN) then we will work with you to make sure your needs are being understood and met. You are the expert in YOU!



If you identify with a different ethnicity or culture, if English is not your first language or if you practice a religion, we will ensure we understand what this means to you. We will support you to be proud of who you are and enable you to maintain links with cultures, communities and practices that are important to you.
