IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19

Dear Potential Ice Show Cast Member,


I am writing to you to hopefully put any prospective concerns and/or feelings of uncertainty at bay as the 2021 ice show season gets underway. We are so excited to be back in the arena and look forward to putting on our much-anticipated annual spring ice show at Suburban Ice Rochester! As most of you are aware, I begin planning for ice show in September of every season, with so much happening behind the scenes before things really start *"going live."* Ice show is unquestionably my favorite event and time of the year, and I was heartbroken that our 2020 celebration show had to be cancelled... I am cautiously optimistic that we will be able to return under the spotlights in 2021!

Right now, it might be difficult to see or comprehend what the climate around us will look like come May, but it is important to recognize that ice show is executed on a precise timetable. Because of that, we need to proceed as if the show is **GOING** to happen, in an effort to stay on track with all planning purposes. If we wait, and it looks like the show will/could happen, it will likely be too late for me to execute on the backend...

Since the cancellation of our 2020 ice show, myself, the OSA board and arena have turned our attention to the 2021 season, and while we recognize things may not even be 100% by next April/May, we will challenge ourselves to find new or creative ways to ensure this seasons show will take place. So while we may be successful in hosting our annual show in 2021, it might be under new or different restrictions. Nevertheless, it is our continued goal that you and your performer will feel part of a professional, inclusive and safe environment. As much as we want the show to happen, we would never proceed in a manner that is deemed unsafe.

Please be aware that if it is determined again that we absolutely cannot host our annual show, you would absolutely be refunded and/or issued a credit. Refund and/or credit totals would again be based on where in the planning stages of the show the cancellation occurs. **Either way, Suburban Ice Rochester will make it right, just as they did this year!**

Right now, I might not have all the answers you may be seeking... Just know that we are truly all in this together, and we will navigate through this time of uncertainty together. I sincerely hope you take the plunge with me and I look forward to seeing your skaters name on the 2021 cast list, as we finally celebrate the OSA's 20th anniversary ice show! Though 2020 did not happen, it is still time for an *Encore!*

- Applications may be submitted to the front desk of either Suburban Ice Rochester or Suburban Ice Macomb.
- Applications must be **COMPLETELY filled out**. We will not accept applications with missing information.
- **Late applications will not be accepted for any reason!**

APPLICATION REQUIREMENT:

- Applications MUST be submitted with an active e-mail address and payment.
- **All ice show correspondence will be sent via e-mail.** *Please use **PRINT** on the application and make sure it is clearly legible.
- Applications will not be accepted without an e-mail address or payment.
 - 1st mailer will be sent out in early-February
 - 2nd mailer will be sent out in early-March
- All information will be posted on the OSA bulletin board at Suburban Ice Rochester, as well as on the club website at www.onyxskatingacademy.com

PARENT VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT:

- A parent or an adult family member of a cast member **MUST VOLUNTEER** for one job during the weekend of the shows. One volunteer commitment **per last name** is required.
- If a parent/adult family member does not sign up for a job or does not show up for a job, the skater will not be able to participate in future ice shows.
- Volunteer sign-up will be online at [EntryEeze](#) and will begin at least one month prior to the show dates.
- **Please only sign up for one job!** Extra jobs will be made available after all parents have signed up.
- We will need parents to help with advance preparation. These opportunities will be shared as they become available.
- **This parent ice show volunteer requirement does NOT satisfy OSA service hour requirements.**
- As part of its SafeSport Program, U.S. Figure Skating announced it has expanded the list of adults required to complete SafeSport training and background checks for the 2020-21 membership year. This will affect members and volunteers, over the age of 18, who are in a position of authority over an athlete or anyone who has frequent contact with athletes. **This includes all volunteers in any sanctioned events or club activities who come in contact with athletes, including backstage and locker room volunteers for all ice shows and club events. This is not an OSA mandated program; it comes from US Figure Skating!** For our club to stay Safesport compliant, we are **requiring** all parent volunteers who wish to work backstage, to complete this training and background check. If you do not wish to pay the \$30.00 fee for the background check, there will be **MULTIPLE** other jobs to choose from. **If you elect not to pay and complete the background check and SafeSport training, you will not be allowed backstage for any reason and any backstage position (locker room parent, security, skater check-in) will not be eligible for you to select as your volunteer requirement.** **OSA members, to determine if you are currently compliant, please check the membership site under the 'volunteer' tab.**

REHEARSALS:

- Ice show rehearsals will tentatively begin ***Monday, April 12, 2021**
- All practices will be after school hours or on the weekends. ***We are aware that some rehearsal times will be close to your child's dismissal time from school. Anticipate this potential conflict for technical rehearsals falling on the week of the show.**
- **Be sure to reserve the dates of May 3 - 7, 2021 for technical and dress rehearsals.**
- Attendance is **ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY** for every scheduled rehearsal that applies to your skater.
- A skater may be dismissed from a number due to absences. The choreographer & the ice show director will make this decision.
- There is a two-week break from OSA contract ice to focus on ice show for the week before and week of the show.
- **Some rehearsals subject to take place at Suburban Ice Macomb.**

LEARN TO SKATE PARTICIPANTS:

- **ALL ages and levels** of LTS participants from Suburban Ice Rochester and Suburban Ice Macomb are welcome and **encouraged** to participate in the show.
- LTS participants **MUST** be enrolled in Sessions 3, 4, and 5 of Learn-To-Skate at either facility to be eligible.
- LTS participants will skate in two of the four performances; "A Cast" or "B Cast" **as assigned by the show director.**

ONYX-SUBURBAN SKATING ACADEMY (OSA) MEMBERS:

- **OSA members MUST have an active Fall, Winter, Spring Contract by the due date of this application to be eligible to participate in the show.**
- OSA members will participate in all four performances.
- OSA members have the option to participate in the opening number.
 - **In order to participate in the Act-1 Opening Number, Skater must have passed their JUVENILE FREESKATE or SENIOR MOVES as of December 8, 2020**
 - **In order to participate in the Act-2 Opening Number, Skater must have passed their PRELIMINARY FREESKATE or JUVENILE MOVES as of December 8, 2020**
- **You will either be in ACT 1 Opening or ACT 2 Opening, NOT BOTH!**
- **Please Note: The purchase of an opening ice show costume will be required!**
 - Ice show apparel will be available for purchase.
- Qualifying OSA members will have the opportunity to participate in a solo or feature number in addition to their group number. See box below for qualifying information.

- **Skater MUST HAVE PASSED THEIR **FREE SKATE & MOVES IN THE FIELD** level by December 8, 2020**
- **YOU WILL HAVE UNTIL DECEMBER 8th TO UPDATE YOUR FREE SKATE LEVEL! AFTER THE 8th, NO UPDATES CAN BE MADE TO YOUR APPLICATION! You will be responsible for paying any cost increases.**
- Qualifying feature skaters will be assigned to A/B cast and will perform 2 out of the 4 shows.
- A feature number will consist of 3-6 skaters.
- Skater's free skate level will be verified with his/her coach & USFS.
- Skater must participate in a group number.
- **All groups, solos, and features are determined at the discretion of the skating director. Exceptions may be made under extenuating circumstances. *Please note that ice show qualifying information may change from year to year to fit the needs of our club***

SOLO PERFORMERS:

- Music will be chosen and provided by the ice show director.
- Soloist performers may choose their own costume; however, **it is subject to approval by the ice show director.**
- Soloist will be responsible for the cost of the costume.
- **All costumes must be approved by the ice show director by February 1, 2021.**
- **Official Costume Books will not be available to view until the Show Costumes are announced in January 2021.**
- *If ordering from a catalogue, all orders must go through the Show Director.*
- Practice and choreography will be arranged with the skater's coach and on the skater's own ice time.
- Soloists are responsible for all coaching and practice ice fees incurred.
- **Any changes to music or show order after the information has been assigned and posted, will be made at the discretion of the director.**

FEATURE PERFORMERS:

- Music will be chosen and provided by the ice show director.
- **Feature performers will meet with the Director on assigned dates to choose and order their costume.** Feature performers are responsible for the cost of the costume.
- **Official Costume Books will not be available to view until the Show Costumes are announced in January 2021.**
- *If ordering from a catalogue, all orders must go through the Show Director.*
- Practice ice will be assigned and is included in the feature fee.
- Feature performers are responsible for the choreographer's fee. **The total cost will be divided among the feature skaters and is not based on how many practices you individually attend.**
- If a situation occurs which requires moving a skater to a different feature or group, other criteria will be considered ONLY when deemed necessary. All such decisions will be made at the discretion of the show director.
- **Any changes to feature assignments, music or show order after the information has been assigned and posted, will be made at the discretion of the director.**

GROUP ASSIGNMENTS:

- Group members will be chosen according to freestyle level.
- Due to large numbers of skaters being at the same free skate level, other criteria such as moves in the field level, age, consistent jumps and seniority number will be considered ONLY when deemed necessary. All such decisions will be made at the discretion of the director.
- Group assignments will be posted by the OSA bulletin board at Suburban Ice Rochester by December 2020.
- **Any changes to group assignments, music or show order after the information has been assigned and posted, will be made at the discretion of the director.**
- Be sure to give the correct measurements for your skater. Costumes will be ordered the third week of December 2020 and we cannot change or add costumes once your form is submitted. **If you are unsure of a size, always order larger!**

GRADUATING SENIOR PRODUCTION:

- All 2021 graduating seniors can elect to participate in a production number for **graduating seniors only!**
- This group number is offered **in addition** to your ice show registration. **It is not offered as a stand-alone group.**
- **Please Note: The purchase of a costume will be required, and the fee will be included with your application!**

OSA ALUMNI PRODUCTION:

- All OSA Alumni are invited and can elect to participate in a production number during the 2021 spring ice show.
- This group number is **a stand-alone group and does not include any other participation in the show.** Skater must be in **good standing** with the OSA to be eligible to participate. ***Open to all levels.**
- Skater does **NOT** need an active OSA membership to be eligible to participate.
- Practice will take place beginning on or around the week of May 1st. The group will have limited rehearsal time.
- **Please Note: The purchase of a costume will be required, and the fee will be included with your application!**
