SOLO AND FEATURE APPLICATION FEES AND INFORMATION:

- Solos and Features are **exclusively for OSA skaters with an OSA coach ONLY**
- ***SOLO and FEATURE numbers will be first come first serve***
 - **Priority is for our no-test through preliminary skaters**
 - **All Pre-Juvenile and up skaters are encouraged to turn in applications and will be added based on first come first served (time stamped) if room is available**
 - Solo/Feature application payments for pre-juvenile (pre-bronze) and up will not be processed if you do not end up in the show
- This year, OSA members have the option of applying for a solo **OR** feature, not both
- The show will be limited to 35 solos and 35 features
- Features may be selected by the skaters and consist of two to five skaters
 - All feature applications must have matching names
- **\$40.00 application fee for solos**
- **\$30.00 application fee per skater for features**
- Please make checks payable to: **SUBURBAN ICE MACOMB**
- Solo and Feature skaters are responsible for their own costumes
- Application fees will go toward ice costs and decorations

SOLO AND FEATURE REHEARSALS:

- There will be no specific practice time allotted for solo and feature rehearsals. All programs must be worked on during a skater's ice time
- Before an application is submitted, it must have a coach's signature agreeing to choreograph the routine
- Arrangements for choreography should be made with the skater's coach
- Parents are responsible for all coaching and ice time fees incurred

MUSIC SELECTION FOR SOLO AND FEATURE:

- Skaters are responsible for the selection and cutting of their own music
- Beginning **November 2nd, music selections** may be turned in for approval by the skating director (on a first come, first serve basis)
- Repeat titles may not be used in the show; selections will be granted on a first come, first serve basis.
- **All final music edits must be emailed to the skating director, in MP3 format by Saturday, November 16th.**
- If final music edits have not been approved and received by **Saturday, November 16th**: your skater **will be removed** from the Holiday Spectacular show with **no refund**
- **MUSIC EDITS may not exceed 1 minute 30 seconds in length**

TICKET PRICES:

- Admission will be set at a minimum **\$6** donation to the Michigan Humane Society
- All tickets to the show will be sold at the door...no advanced ticket sales

Girth: _____ **Bust/Chest:** _____ **Waist:** _____ **Hips:** _____ **Street Clothing**
Size: _____

- **Girth** - Girth is the most important measurement when determining size! To measure girth, place a tape measure at the top of the shoulder (typically where a standard leotard strap sits), then over the apex (fullest part of the chest), down through the crotch and back up to the same shoulder. Measuring tape should follow close to the body shape.
- **Bust/Chest** - Measure over the apex (fullest part of the chest) with your arms relaxed at your sides. Tape must be horizontal around the body.
- **Waist** - Find your natural waist breakpoint by bending to the side (typically 1" to 1 1/2" above the belly button). Stand straight and measure around your natural waist breakpoint. Make sure breathing is relaxed during this measurement. Tape must be horizontal around the body.
- **Hips** - Measure around the fullest part of the hips and buttocks while standing with your feet together. Tape must be horizontal around the body.

All Practices are MANDATORY! Practice times, along with the choreographers for each group will be confirmed via email by November 3rd, 2024. Group practices will begin approximately four weeks prior to the show.
