Membership & SafeSport Compliance:

Memberships must be renewed and active in order to register for the FWS Skating Contract. Membership applications are available online ONLY! For renewal please visit www.onyxskatingacademy.com and click on the membership tab.

U.S. Figure Skating is committed to providing a safe, healthy and positive skating environment for all members and volunteers.

In 2018, as part of its SafeSport Program, U.S. Figure Skating announced it has expanded the list of adults required to complete SafeSport training and background checks for each membership year. This will affect members and volunteers, over the age of 18, who are in a position of authority over an athlete or anyone who has frequent contact with athletes. This includes all volunteers in any sanctioned events or club activities who come in contact with athletes and locker room volunteers for all competitions, ice shows and club events. This is not an OSA mandated program; it comes from U.S. Figure Skating! In order for our club to stay SafeSport compliant, we are requiring all parent volunteers to complete this training. SAFESPORT TRAINING MUST BE COMPLETED ANNUALLY. BACKGROUND CHECKS ARE VALID FOR THE SEASON IN WHICH A DETERMINATION IS ISSUED AND THE FOLLOWING SEASON WITH A 12 MONTH AUTOMATIC RECHECK.

Seniority Numbers:

Seniority numbers were assigned on July 1, 2026 to all OSA members for the 2026-2027 membership year. Your current seniority number will be used for the 2026-2027 FWS contract and Summer Skating contract.

Payments:

There are three payment options; Payment in full, in thirds or sixths. A payment is due at registration. Contracts will not be accepted without payment. Payments may be made with cash, ACH, check (made payable to Suburban Ice Macomb) or credit/debit card. ***PLEASE NOTE*** If using ACH or credit/debit card, your invoice will be set up for automatic payments with whatever plan you choose. **ALL CONTRACTS \$750 AND UNDER MUST BE PAID IN FULL OR WITH A 3-PAYMENT PLAN. All credit/debit card transactions will incur a 3.25% processing fee.** It is very important that all payments be made on time, otherwise ice privileges may be suspended at the discretion of Suburban Ice Macomb. **Payments made a week late will result in a \$25.00 late fee. Payments two or more weeks late will result in a late payment fee and the skater being removed from OSA contract ice until payment is made.**

Ice Time Changes:

Changes to the Fall/Winter/Spring contract will only be allowed until February 20, 2027, with a \$15.00 administrative fee. After this date there will be no changes allowed under any circumstances. There will be no deletions allowed to your contract once the FWS season has begun.

Registration:

Each session has 24 spots available and will be assigned based on your seniority number. If a session should fill up, there will be a waitlist. Please have a "back up plan" in case you do not receive your first choices. Any registration handed in after August 18th will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.

Please hand in a hard copy of your contract, along with payment at the arena front desk during the registration window: Monday, August 10th-Tuesday, August 18th.

A 3.25% processing fee will be added to all credit/debit card payments. A \$40 bank fee will be added for all returned checks. A \$25 late fee will be added to invoiced payments over 1 week late. Payments 2 weeks late will result in the skater's removal from the ice. A \$15 administrative fee will be assessed for all changes to your contract. No refunds or deletions will be granted after the contract has begun.

Please read and sign below

1. Skaters must be a renewed member of Onyx Suburban Skating Academy (OSSA).
2. Skaters must use assigned locker rooms to change equipment.
3. All skaters must sign in at the arena front desk prior to taking the ice.
4. If a skater is unable to skate for 14 or more consecutive days due to injury or illness they may request that their contract be canceled until the skater can resume normal skating activities. This request should be submitted in writing along with a doctor's letter indicating the extent of the injury in order to document the request. The contracted skater is still responsible for paying their contract ice payments.
5. Absolutely no eating, drinking or gum chewing on the ice with the exception of water bottles.
6. Proper respect must be shown to all professionals, monitors, instructors, fellow skaters and parents.
7. Ice sessions are for training purposes, any other use such as excessive talking, cell phone / texting use, will result in expulsion from the session. Foul language or show of temper is not allowed, and the skater will be asked to leave the ice.
8. Suburban Ice Macomb (SIM) reserves the right to cancel scheduled events without liability, other than reimbursement credit.
9. Suburban Ice Macomb shall not be liable for any claim or action resulting in injury, or damaged or lost property, which may be sustained in connection with any SIM activity.
10. Repeated or serious infractions of the rules will result in loss of ice privileges. All skaters and parents must adhere to the skater and parent code of conduct set forth by the USFS.
11. Recognizing the normal risk of skating on ice, I agree to skate at my own risk and to abide by all skating policies established by Suburban Ice Macomb management and the Onyx Suburban Skating Academy and/or professionals. Suburban Ice Macomb assumes no responsibility for accidents on or off the ice, or damage to personal property.
