SCHOOL TIMING :

Learners must arrive on campus **punctually**, ensuring they are present **before the designated reporting time**.

KG Section: 9:15 a.m. – 3:40 p.m.

Primary & Secondary: 8:50 a.m. – 3:40 p.m.

STUDENT DISCIPLINE :

Students are expected to come to school in a **clean, well-groomed, and complete uniform**, which symbolizes **discipline, unity, and the institution's identity**. Consistent attendance is vital for **steady academic growth and uninterrupted learning**, therefore **absences should be minimized** and allowed only when absolutely unavoidable.

SCHOOL DAYS :

Monday to Friday are considered **standard instructional days** for all students. Kindergarten learners enjoy holidays every Saturday and Sunday, while Primary and Secondary students follow the **Annual Academic Calendar** or **official school notifications** for Saturday engagements and additional holidays. In the event of **severe weather conditions** or any **emergency situation**, the school reserves the full authority to **announce or declare a holiday** as necessary.

We encourage our students to participate in more skill-based and cultural competitions (like)

SAFAL Program : Strengthens foundational literacy and numeracy.

Inter-School Competitions : Our students achieving more from other school cultural competition. It will broadcast our student talent.

Sports :

We place great emphasis on sports and physical activities. Our students actively take part in CBSE tournaments as well as zonal and state-level competitions, earning awards and certificates for their achievements.

Every Friday during the morning session, we conduct special training for students. They are required to bring the necessary sports equipment and come dressed in the school sports uniform.

Every year on August 29, we observe National Sports Day, and our school hosts its annual sports celebration on the same day. Participation in this event is compulsory for all students.

Examinations :

Please refer to the Annual Calendar for all examination dates.

For significant assessments, an Admit Card will be provided and must be brought without fail.

Attendance during exams is mandatory.

Educational Field Trips :

Excursions help boost intelligence, broaden knowledge, and provide practical, real-world experience.

Parents are encouraged to allow their children to participate for greater exposure and learning opportunities.

School Transport :

The school provides a free **bus facility** for students.

All students must strictly follow **bus safety rules**; failing to do so may result in cancellation of bus privileges.

Students must reach the bus stop **a little early** to ensure timely boarding.

Academic Fees :

All fees must be paid on or before the **mentioned due dates**.

Term I: Last date – **March 31**

Term II: Last date – **August 31**

* Payments made after the due date, or any damage caused to school property by students, will attract a penalty.

Annual Day :

Participation in Annual Day programs is **mandatory** for all students.

Students will be provided opportunities to **display their talents** through various cultural and stage performances.

Rewards :

Students achieving at the national level will receive a 50% scholarship, encouraging excellence and dedication in their chosen fields. STEM regular followers and achievers will be rewarded with study materials worth ₹3000 to support their continuous learning journey. The best-performing students will receive additional special rewards in recognition of their outstanding efforts.

Altogether, these rewards and opportunities are designed to enhance children's overall development and inspire them to grow with confidence and curiosity.

Accessories :

The school has provided accessories according to the needs of the students in the respective classes. Any additional accessories required, or (damaged/lost) items, can be purchased from the school office by paying the necessary amount.






