### Charity T466 & Family Background in the Synergy Program:

Charity T466 is a special cow to us as she represents the growth and development of our breeding program from buying his great great granddam (Lake Wagyu D044) in Australia in 2013 on through to our investment in Mayura Itoshigenami JNR semen in 2020 and now with her and her progeny ranking in elite EBV company globally at the top of the Index lists.

Charity is a direct daughter of Mayura Itoshigenami JNR, the “King of Australian Sires”. His semen has sold to a world record \$70,000 per straw and live progeny have sold to \$280,000! She is also tested recessive free! Charity is the #3 BFI recessive free JNR daughter in the world and #1 in the USA!

JNR is a true once in a generation sire and the foundation of the Mayura Station branded beef program. He has more than 1,000 carcasses in the Mayura herd consistently grading AUS-Meat 9+, with leading ribeye area and carcass weight at a young age. JNR’s breed leading EBVs are backed up by jaw dropping raw data averages from Mayura Station (2019 Data) on 805 carcasses of 9.05 MS, 448 kg (985.6 lbs.) HSCW, and 109 cm<sup>2</sup> (16.90 in<sup>2</sup>) EMA (10th/11th rib).




532G, her donor dam is one of our best cows in the Synergy herd. She is extremely fertile and raises fantastic calves to compliment her top notch phenotype perfectly. She carries outstanding depth, strength, and width from front to back and is a great example of the ideal wagyu cow (Pictured). We have harvested a maternal brother to her (Ribeye pictured) with tremendous results. This speaks volumes on the potential of this fantastic young cow! This incredible marble fineness and even distribution throughout the ribeye. We harvested this steer before we were using a carcass camera to evaluate our steers, however it is still of of our “prettiest” ribeyes to date!



The elite Sumo Cattle Company super-sire Sumo Michifuku F154 was bred by the late Simon Coates. He is a World K's Michifuku son proven through the Sumo herd where he has averaged a fantastic 8.3 MS with a 987.8 lbs HCW on 34 carcasses.

He has 79 carcasses on his Breedplan proof producing elite EBVs of 2.4 MS, 5.5 EMA, and 32 CW (Feb2 2024).

F154 has produced many sale topping females and males in Australia and the USA. Including a daughter selling for \$80,000 in the 2019 Elite Wagyu Sale and a son selling for \$50,000. In 2020 a daughter topped the M6 Ranch sale for \$50,000. F154's balance of growth, marbling, carcass weight, and ribeye area are what has set him apart and at the top of the breed indexes from the FTI to the SRI!

He combines Michifuku with his maternal grandsire TF Terutani 40/1, an outstanding sire who's genetics were never available outside Australia. 40/1 was Takeda bred and Sumo Wagyu proven and owned, he is renowned for making impressive females with fantastic maternal traits. 40/1 had carcass data published in the 2018 Wagyu Full-blood Sale catalog from Salisbury Wagyu and Sanjoliney Wagyu. On 106 carcasses in the Sanjoliney herd he was their 4th highest carcass weight bull and 8th highest marble score bull. This puts him in 4th place for their carcass value ranking behind Itohana 2, Overflow Kaneyama, and TF 148, but ahead of breed greats Michifuku, TF 151, TF 147, and 001. In the Salisbury herd 40/1 ranked 7th for ADG and 6th for MS making him one of the best overall sires in the herd.

### **PEPPERMILL GROVE D139 (AI) (ET)**

Behind Sumo F154 is Peppermill Grove D139, who was selected to contribute outcross Westholme genetics to the pedigree that contribute much needed growth and maternal traits to the Michifuku cow D044. He is a Hatsuhi maternal line sire. The Hatsuhi family is widely regarded as the best Tottori/Kedaka family to have been exported from Japan. He worked perfectly to balance the marbling and ribeye traits of Michifuku with the growth and maternals of D139. As we follow the pedigree back it is all Takeda genetics behind the Michifuku sired D044 cow.

The Chiyotake 8 maternal line is no stranger to success having produced breed leading proven sires including: Mayura Quantum, Mayura Precision, Mayura Admiral, Macquarie Wagyu M0546, Macquarie Prelude, Macquarie M00491, Macquarie Wagyu Y408, and many more!

D139 was used specifically to infuse growth and maternal qualities through his Hatsuhi maternal line and Westholme sires. Charity boasts a pedigree that is now impossible to replicate. She is built on a modern pedigree of proven bulls with high EBV accuracies. Charity is extremely well-balanced and is the only female in Breedplan with her balance of genomic EBV traits for 200, 400, and 600 Day Weights, Milk, Carcass Weight, EMA, Marble Score, and Marble Finess (July run 2)! She covers all the bases with her elite pedigree, huge EBVs, and great flush results. She flushed very well as a heifer and her dam was a prolific donor, too. Charity has already produced several high genomic progeny over 500 BFI. She is at the very height of her productive life as she is a recently calved two-year-old who can put into a long-term donor program. The return on investment will be immense with Charity.
