Prioritize Video Projection And Display

Enhancing the worship experience often involves visual elements such as song lyrics, scripture verses, and multimedia presentations. To achieve this, we will invest in quality video projection and display systems. High-definition projectors or large LED displays can make a significant difference in visibility and impact.

2. Capital Construction Projects

Shiloh Baptist Church of Jamaica will embark on two major capital projects that address both the internal and external appearance and functionality of the buildings.

For example, the church Fellowship Hall, a space designed to be versatile and well-used, is limiting our ability to do the kinds of ministry and community building we'd like to but can't right now. I'd love to start weeknight support group meetings for youth and families, have more pot-luck gatherings, training events, and other studies and socials, but none of that can happen until we make these necessary changes.
