KUPUNA COMMUNITY CARE NETWORK UPDATE

On behalf of the staff and board of directors of Kula No Nā Po‘e Hawai‘i, we’d like to extend our sincere appreciation for your support and participation in the Papakōlea Kūpuna Community Care Network Program, also known as KCCN. Funded for the past 3 years by the U.S. Administration for Native Americans (ANA), the \$1.2 million grant supported the development and implementation of KCCN serving 250+ kūpuna and their caregivers.

We are glad to report that over 3 years, KCCN served a total of 381 kūpuna including 99 caregivers, conducted 78 cultural and health workshops, and enjoyed 29 excursions (huaka‘i). KCCN also provided home visits, medical supplies and equipment to kūpuna and increased access to information and services empowering families to support kūpuna safely aging in place. With the support of community partners, KCCN provided over 10,000 meals and 3,000 food boxes during this COVID-19 pandemic.

As a result of our hard work and collective efforts, we are proud to announce ANA awarded KULA with a second grant in the amount of \$1.2m for an additional 3 years to support the continued efforts of Papakōlea’s next level KCCN program. KCCN II continues the legacy of our founding kūpuna to achieve “health equity” and “aging safely in place”. For the next 3 years we will move closer to our long-term community goal by increasing the use of technology, modifying education and training (with a specific focus on pandemic response and Dementia), and increasing home and community safety.
