In partnership with Altres, grocery boxes (milk, eggs, bread, produce, meal, etc.) are available for community families. **Due to limited supply and increased need, you must register for each distribution with Kula staff.** Reservations begin the Monday of the distribution week and are taken on a first come, first serve basis. Please see schedule below. If boxes are still available, Kula staff begins calling previous recipients starting on Wednesday. Due to high demand, we do not leave voicemails, but will return your call if you leave us a message. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we strive to accommodate everyone as best as we can.

Lanakila Meals Grab & Go Program

We have partnered with Lanakila Meals to provide kūpuna ages 60 & older with 7 frozen USDA compliant meals on Wednesdays @ 10:30am. For more information or to sign up, contact Mahealani Austin @ 561-4011.

To qualify you must meet the requirements:

- KCCN Participant*
- 60 years and older
- Complete Lanakila Meals Application & Participation Agreement Form
- Copy of photo ID
- Must pick up meals at Papakolea Community Center (upper hall) 10:30-11am *Delivery is available for kupuna without transportation*

*New applicants 55+ years and their caregivers are welcome

Kūpuna Lunch Delivery
