**All are welcome to join in the fun** and sew something for one of the charities our club supports.

You may bring your own charity project, make something using the fabrics from the cabinets, use your own pattern or ones located on our website.

Minimum sizes of quilts for each charity are posted on the website. Please keep quilts close to these sizes. None of our organizations can use a quilt larger than twin, but the most common size needed is a lap size.

**You are no longer required to have a backing, batting and binding when you donate your quilt top.**

1. If you would like to quilt and bind your charity quilt top, we can provide batting, backing, binding or whatever you need to complete the quilt.

2. If you prefer to make the quilt top only, you may turn it in to the "Quilt Tops only" bin in Cabinet 104S. The CS Committee will cut batting, prepare backing and make it available for Longarm volunteers to quilt and bind it. **Please use the website to order your batting and specify just the quilt top measurements only. We will add the needed for longarming the quilt.**

**3.** Please add the Quilt Creation Form to your quilt/quilt top before placing it in the cabinet. The forms are on the door of cabinet 104S in small plastic bags with a care label and safety pin for your use. **You can also print the form from the website.**

Come and spend the morning, bring or buy lunch and come back for the afternoon or go home for the day. OR just come in the afternoon, whatever you prefer. Your help is greatly appreciated!
