President, Ronda Jones called the meeting to order at 7pm in the Chianti Room. She reminded everyone to please silence their phones.

Treasurer: George reported \$4537 in checking account and \$10,108 in the Longarm Repair fund.

Community Service: Patsy announced the Sep 25 sew day to make Zippy Strippy Bags from 9:30-3.

Edna deFord has made custom pants for a handicapped man. He was very pleased and they are working very well.

New charity labels are in – Patsy would appreciate your feedback about their size, color, etc.

Fabric in the closets is still currently available to be used for small parts of personal quilts, but is not intended to be for full quilts. Remember the **batting is only for charity quilts**, NOT personal quilts.

Six quilts were just picked up by Natalie's House. The girls receiving them were very touched by the handmade quilts.

Programs: Global Connection – Saturday October 2 and Sunday October 3rd 12-3 pm AZ Time. Email coming out with log in information for these mini-classes. This will help us determine if we want to have one of the presenters come to our club.

Color Wheel Class October 22nd 12-3 pm. Kathleen reminded us that next year's challenge quilts are due on March 1, 2022. This class will help with fabric selection if you are struggling.

Veterans Appreciation Day: Carol reported the Opportunity to purchase tickets to the November 10, 11:30am luncheon is now on the website. PCQ members are \$20 for the luncheon. Guests are \$25. After the luncheon, the program in the theater at 2pm is \$5 and must be purchased through the Activity Office in Eagles Nest. New Business:

1. Maureen Pugsley's husband has donated most of her sewing and quilting supplies to PCQ. While packing them up, he mentioned that he and her 3 children have never received a quilt made by Maureen. Please consider finishing one of her partially finished projects to give back to her husband and children. 2. Holiday Fest will be held on Saturday December 4th - 9-4 pm. The sewing room will be closed to quilters on Friday Dec 3rd Saturday Dec 4th and Sunday Dec 5th. If you want to sell something during this fest, you need to become a consignor. See the gallery for information. We will be selling raffle tickets for the opportunity quilt at the fest.
3. Keys & Entrance to the room: At closing, currently 3pm, the Gallery staff will lock the hallway doors and outside doors. You will not need a key if you are staying in the room after closing. If you want to leave and return, or if you want to use the room on Sunday or when the Gallery is closed, you must get a key from the Gallery and return the key under the door to the Gallery when you leave. Starting Oct 1, the closing will be 4pm Monday – Saturday.
4. Remember we should not go in the room when another club is inside during their regular scheduled times. (Sit and Stitch, Nimble Needlers, etc.) OK to come in if they have left early.
